## **High School Diploma For Veterans**

The 1999 Wisconsin Act 73 gave school districts the authority to award high school diplomas to veterans meeting the qualifications listed below.

- Is at least 65 years old,
- Attended high school in the district,
- Left high school before receiving a high school diploma to join the U.S. armed forces during a war period (including, among others, World War I, World War II, the Korean Conflict, Vietnam War and Persian Gulf War),
- Served on active duty under honorable conditions in the U.S. armed forces or in forces incorporated as part of the U.S. armed forces.

Veterans who wish to receive their diploma are requested to complete the application form and provide supporting documentation that the above criterion applies. The following items (copies – no originals) need to be submitted along with the application:

- Copy of birth certificate, or something showing proof of age,
- Copy of service papers indicating time of service and honorable discharge,
- List of the Kenosha schools attended.
