**TREMPER HIGH SCHOOL CLASSIC YEARBOOK PLACES EIGHTH
IN NATIONAL COMPETITION**

Tremper High School Classic Yearbook placed eighth nationally in the National Scholastic Press Association Best of Show Competition in Anaheim, California, from among the top journalism programs in the United States. Under the leadership of 2007 Editors-in-Chief Stefanie D., Rebecca F., and Dana D. as well as Associate Editor Ainsley M., the yearbook developed "Fuel to the Flame" in writing, theme and design as Wisconsin's only national winner. There were over 4,400 participants. The 2007 yearbook has been named to Walsworth Publishing's Gallery of Excellence, and the 2006 yearbook was featured this year in design across the nation.

Also in Anaheim, three journalists won individually in the Journalism Education Association Write-Off competition. Over 4,400 student delegates from 45 states gathered for the JEA/NSPA national competition. Senior Rebecca F. received Superior first place in Yearbook Layout: Inside Pages. Senior Ainsley M. claimed second place Excellent in Yearbook Copy Writing: Clubs, and Senior Dana D. earned third place Honorable Mention in Yearbook Copy Writing: Academics.

Retired yearbook adviser/English department member Sandy Jacoby was awarded the Medal of Merit and the Lifetime Achievement awards by the Journalism Education Association. Ms. Jacoby was the only adviser in the United States to receive both awards, and was also selected by JEA to be among 10 advisers from across the U.S. to establish a national journalism mentoring program.
