**Hey motorcycle enthusiasts! It's time for our 18<sup>th</sup> Annual BOLD Motorcycle Ride! This year we are going back to the archives . . . our half-way stop will be at the Trout Fishing Ponds in Cascade. All fishing supplies will be provided for us. We will be taking a scenic route to and from Cascade that will include some windy roads and the smell of fresh air will be aplenty! After Trout Fishing we will ride back to Richfield for one of the Richfield Lions legendary dinners. The ride starts, as always, at the Richfield Firehouse, on HWY 175. It could be 40 degrees or 80 degrees so a jacket or sweatshirt is highly recommended because it is cooler on the bike. This ride will happen rain or shine.**

**Two things are needed from you to sign up for this ride:**

- 1. Call in to box #5 by May 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018, 9:00 pm. Period. After you sign up, as always, be on the look-out for your liability form in the mail about A WEEK AFTER May 4<sup>th</sup>.**
- 2. Sign the liability form and RETURN by Friday May 18<sup>th</sup>. (Please use the supplied stamped and pre-addressed return envelope provided for you.)**
- 3. The order the returned forms are received will determine the order riders will be assigned a bike.**
- 4. After 10:00pm on May 4<sup>th</sup>, the call-in line will switch to recording those wishing to be on the wait list to fill any cancelations.**
