## Participant Behavior Notice

Dear Parents,

Your child/children age 6 – 12 are participating in the Kenosha Unified School District Summer Supervised Playground Program. We asked that you keep in mind that the rules established by the Kenosha Unified School District during the school year also apply to the Summer Program.

Please insure that siblings under the age of 6 are not left with the older children that have been enrolled to participate in our program. We will call you to pick up any child at our site that does not meet the age requirement of 6 – 12.

In addition, children are asked to be respectful of our staff and other children participating in this program. We have **Zero Tolerance** for misbehavior and we have outlined below the corrective steps that we will follow to keep all participants safe during our activities:

1. There is **No Hitting Allowed**
2. The use of **Inappropriate Language** is **Not Allowed**
3. Participants and Staff will be respectful to one another
4. Participants will follow the directions of our Playground Staff Directors/Supervisors

### **Failure to follow the above rules will result in the following actions:**

1. **First Offense:** The Playground Director will call the parent and write up a Behavior Report and placed in time out.
2. **Second Offense:** The Playground Director will call the parent, write up a Behavior Report and the Child will be **asked to immediately leave the Playground for the rest of the day and we ask that the parent sign them in the next day and talk with the staff.**
3. **Third Offense:** The Playground Director will call the parent, write up a Behavior Report **and the Child will be asked to immediately leave Playground and not return for the next 3 days and we ask that the parent sign them in the day they return and talk with the staff.**
4. **Fourth Offense:** The child will be asked **Not to return for the rest of the summer.**

**Your child may not be able to attend field trips if he/she has more than 2 Behavior Reports on file during the current Summer Program.**
