Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

The Kenosha eSchool will be administering the “Measures of Academic Progress” (MAP) assessment for all full-time eSchool students grades 2-8. All students are required to take this test three times a year; once in the fall, winter, and spring. The MAP test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that is used in KUSD to monitor student growth and identify academic development over time. The computerized test is required by the District as a “benchmark” assessment.

Students will be tested by grade level at the eSchool building located at 1808 41<sup>st</sup> Place. The test takes approximately two hours to complete. Please reference the schedule below to verify the date and time your child should report to eSchool:

<p>* Students should report to the eSchool building at 8:45 a.m. to begin their MAP test.</p> <p>* Students will have the option to complete the Reading part after they take the Math section on Tuesday, September 25<sup>th</sup> only-if both sections are completed on Tuesday, students will not need to return on Wednesday.</p> <p>* Please know that students complete the MAP assessments at their own pace and may finish before 12:00 p.m.</p>
