Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

The Kenosha eSchool will be administering the computer-based ACT Aspire Interim test to current 9th and 10th graders three times during the 2018-2019 school year. The first assessment session will be administered on Tuesday, October 9th and Wednesday, October 10th from 9:30 a.m.-11:00 a.m. on both mornings. Students will be tested on the Reading and Math the first day, and the English and Science the second day.

The ACT Aspire Interim is a benchmarked, standards-based system of assessment in Reading, English, Mathematics, and Science. The district will utilize the score reports to highlight individual student progress towards College Readiness standards and benchmarks. The overall goal of this assessment program is to provide timely, relevant achievement data on every freshman and sophomore as they begin their high school academic career. With this critical data in hand, district and school personnel can immediately gain insights and plan academic supports and growth opportunities for all students to enjoy success in the classroom.

Students will be tested at the eSchool office located at **1808 41st Place**. Each test takes 45 minutes maximum so the testing time is approximately 3 hours total but divided into two sessions that are administered over the course of two days. Please reference the schedule below to verify the dates and times your child should report to the eSchool location.

Students must attend each session in order to complete all of the necessary sections of the exam. **Failure to attend and complete the ACT Aspire Interim test can lead to suspension of your eSchool courses and/or removal from eSchool at the end of the quarter.** Any student who misses a portion of the test will be required to make it up.
