

# Middle School Enrichment Program

## How will this program work?

- Students work on eSchool courses during their scheduled English and math time during four class periods each week
- Face to face session with the eSchool teacher scheduled weekly
- Time required to complete assignments outside of the designated class times is considered homework
- Student support available via chat, virtual office hours, e-mail, course discussion boards, text message, phone call, and weekly face-to-face sessions

## Program Goals

- Increase number of identified gifted and talented students achieving an advanced score on the ACT in grade 11
- Increase the number of identified gifted and talented students completing four years of Honors, AP and/or Youth Options math and English courses with a grade of “B” or higher
- Increase the number of juniors participating in AP Calculus



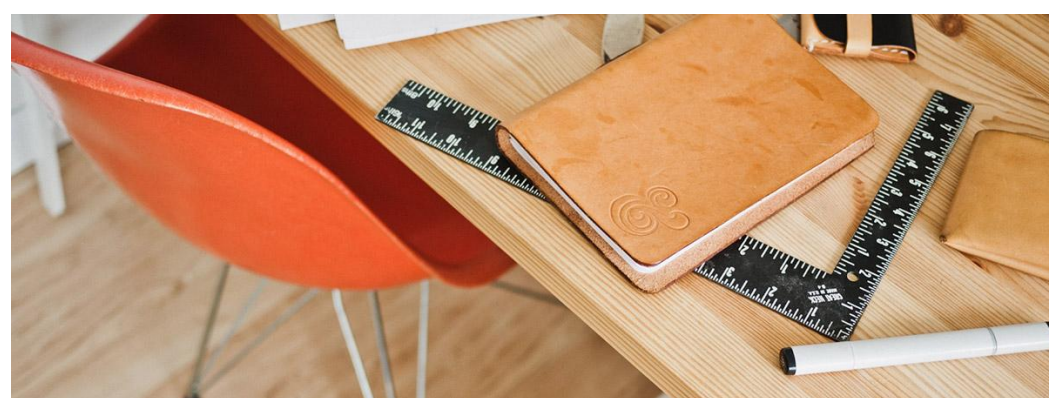
## Talent Development Program Vision
