Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

Kenosha eSchool will be administering the “Measures of Academic Progress” (MAP) assessment for students in grades K-5. The MAP’s test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that KUSD uses as a benchmark to monitor student growth and to identify academic development in both reading and math.

Testing will be administered in person at the eSchool building located at 1808 41st Place. (Enter on the west side of the building.) It is an untimed test so the students finish at various times. Please reference the schedule below to see the dates and times your child should report to the eSchool building to complete their MAPS test.
