Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

Kenosha eSchool will be administering the "Measures of Academic Progress" (MAP) assessment for students in grades K-8 the week of September 19th. The MAP's test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that KUSD uses as a benchmark to monitor student growth and to identify academic development in both reading and math.

Testing will be administered in person at the eSchool building located at 1808 41st Place. (Enter on the west side of the building.) The duration of the test is approximately two hours. It is an untimed test so this can vary by the individual student. Please reference the schedule below to verify the date and time your child should report to the eSchool building.

Grades 6-8	Thursday, September 21	10:00 a.m. − 12:00 p.m.
