Dear Parent/Guardians and Students:

Kenosha eSchool will be administering the "Measures of Academic Progress" (MAP) assessment for students in grades K-8 the week of May 12. The MAP's test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that KUSD uses as a benchmark to monitor student growth and to identify academic development in both reading and math.

Testing will be administered to students in grades K-8 in person at the eSchool building located at 1808 41st Place. (Enter on the west side of the building.) The duration of the test is approximately two hours. It is an untimed test so this can vary by the individual student.

There are two dates you can choose to have your child complete the MAPS test. (They only need to attend one session.) Please reference the schedule below.

Please have your child bring their school issued Chromebook fully charged on testing day.
