Dear Parent/Guardian-

Students in Wisconsin in grades 3-8 participate in the Wisconsin Forward standardized testing during the window of March 17 – April 25. The Wisconsin Forward Exam is designed to gauge how well students are doing in relation to the Wisconsin Academic Standards. (Please see the attached letter for more information and resources regarding the test.)

Testing will be administered in-person at the eSchool/Ruth Harman Academy building on Tuesday, March 18 and Wednesday, March 19 from 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Students complete subject areas based on grade level. See the chart below for the breakdown of assigned subject subtests by grade level. Please note, this is not a timed test, so students complete their tests at their own pace. Testing times indicated below are only approximate. Students can call for a ride home when they finish.

Grade Level	Subjects Tested	Approximate time needed to complete all assigned subtests
Grades 3, 5, 6, and 7	English Language Arts & Math	Approximately 3.5 hours
Grades 4 & 8	English Language Arts, Math, Science, & Social Studies	Approximately 5.5 hours

Please have your child bring their Kenosha Unified School District chrome book fully charged. We will supply headphones, scratch paper, pencils, etc. We will also have water and snacks for students.
