Dear Parent and Student:

Students in grades 1-8 who are attending The Kenosha eSchool program will take the MAPS "Measures of Academic Progress" assessment during the week of May 12, 2025. The MAP's test is a computer-adaptive assessment tool that KUSD uses as a benchmark to monitor student growth and to identify academic development in both reading and math. Choose one of the days listed below for your child to take the MAPS test. (Students only need to attend one of the two days.)

Day & Date	Time
Tuesday, May 13	9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.
OR	
Wednesday, May 14	9:00 a.m. - 11:00 a.m.

The MAPS test will be administered in person at the eSchool building, located at 8518 22nd Avenue. Students are to enter at door 13 located on the northeast corner of the building. Parents who want to walk their child into the building can park on the North or East side of the building. The duration of the test is approximately two hours. It is an untimed test so the amount of time needed varies by the individual student. Students can call their parent if they finish earlier than 11:00.

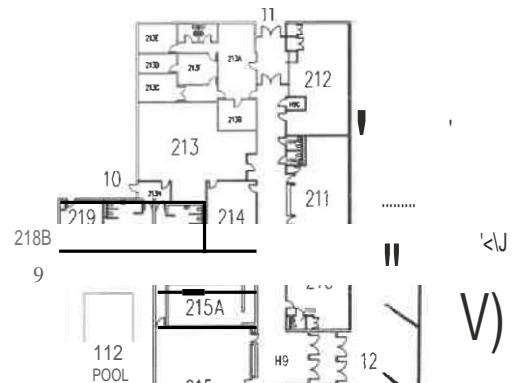

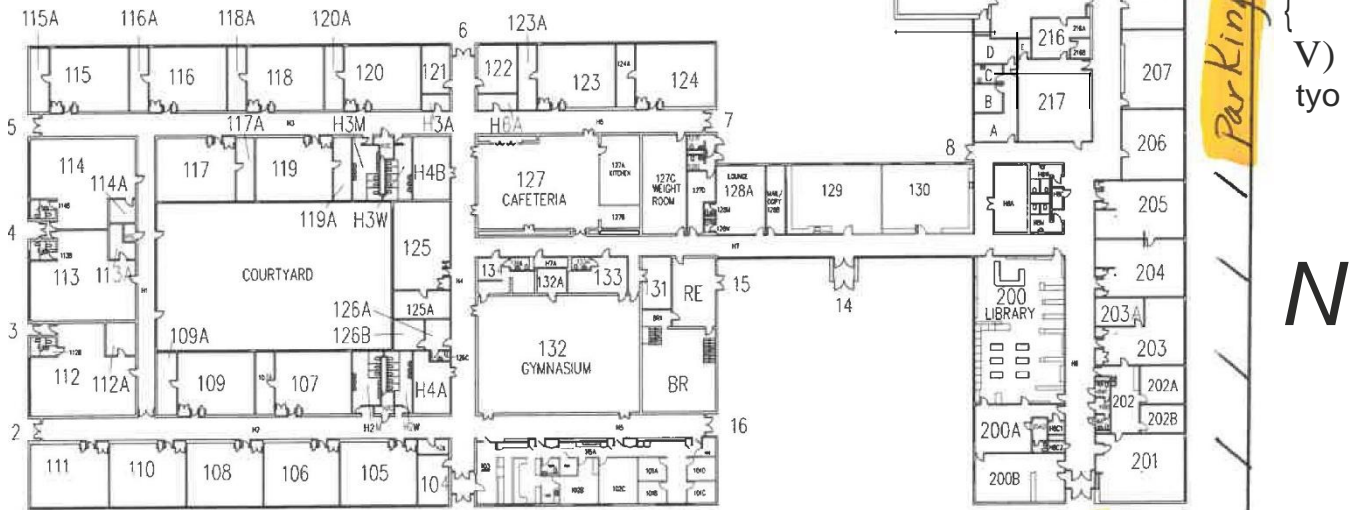
