

Shortened Pace Agreement

Current eSchool Program courses for .5 credits are taken over a standard nine (9) week period. A student may complete their work during a shorter period when the amount of time assigned has an equivalent amount of associated course work. For example, a full time student would attempt four (4) courses over nine (9) weeks. A full time student who only had five (5) weeks may be assigned just two (2) courses. This would equate to a faster pace but a smaller course load. There are a number of justifiable reasons when this scenario would appear, such as time constraints or special circumstances. Proper communication and agreement are key components to following this agreement. The student and parent must abide by the agreement, as this is also based on available space. The existing eSchool Program three (3) week drop window (without penalty of a failing grade) still applies.
