I hope you had a restful vacation filled with fun family moments and the making of new memories.

Now that rightsizing decisions have been finalized, you may review current and future boundary school maps online at:

Families with current 4th and 7th grade students impacted by rightsizing boundary changes will have received an email with information about remaining at their current school.

The annual Parent Initiated Transfer (PIT) process outlined in policy 5330 will run from January 1- January 21, 2024. All families will receive a letter in the mail in mid-January outlining their assigned 2024-2025 boundary schools to assist in making decisions outlined below. Please note that this letter will NOT indicate any current choice/charter school enrollments or existing approved transfers to schools that will remain open next year. Prior to receiving the letter, you may consult the Boundary School Locators noted above to determine how boundary changes may impact your household.

Parents/guardians who want their child to attend a boundary school other than their assigned school must submit a PIT request form. Students on a currently approved PIT do not need to submit a new request form to remain at their current school building unless it happens to be one impacted by rightsizing. If their current school is closing due to rightsizing, they will either return to their assigned boundary school OR submit a new PIT request form for another school of their choice. Electronic PIT request forms opened on January 1 and will close on January 21. If you have questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to us here at Grant.
