BOTTOMS:

- May not be see-through or drag on the floor
- Must be clean with no rips and/or holes that expose skin above mid-thigh
- Must cover undergarments at all times and appropriately fastened with belts when needed
- Must cover the waistline and no skin may show between bottoms and tops when seated or standing
 - Must be at least mid-thigh length and cover all private body parts at all times



TOPS:

- May not be see-through
- Must be clean with no rips or holes
- Must cover the waistline and no skin may show between bottoms and tops when seated or standing
- Must cover all undergarments and private body parts at all times
- May wear a tank top if the straps are at least one inch in width



FOOTWEAR:

- Athletic shoes, laced shoes, shoe boots, loafers, dress shoes or sandals (are permissible)
- Must be secured on the feet
- No house slippers are allowed



STUDENT ID CARDS:

• All students must have an ID in their possession at all times and have them easily accessible during all school activities (e.g. academic, extra-curricular, cocurricular).

ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES:

- At times, students will be required to dress semi-professional for certain school related events, such as, celebrations of learning, student led conferences and passages, etc.
- Clothing representing gangs or gang-related activity, including gang-related colors if for purposes of gang identification, may not be worn
- Clothing that contains pictures and/or writing referring to weapons, alcoholic beverages, tobacco products, sexual references, profanity, illegal drugs, bigoted epithets, harassment/hate messages, or messages of hostility toward race, ethnicity, religion or sexual orientation may not be worn
- Pajamas may not be worn as outerwear.
- Attire that may be considered a weapon is not allowed (e.g. chain belts, wallet chains, etc.)
- Jewelry, piercing, tattoos or similar artifacts that are obscene or may cause disruptions to the educational environment are prohibited
- Hoods, bandanas, skullcaps, plastic hair bags, hair nets may not be worn within the building, unless the dressing is for religious purposes.
- Grooming items (e.g. hair picks, combs, etc.) may not be worn in the hair
- Outerwear, including winter coats, gloves/mittens and scarves, may not be worn inside unless a student is going to his/her locker or classroom after coming from or going outside, or with administrative approval
- Face coverings (e.g. sunglasses, masks, etc.) may not be worn in the building
- High school students may use backpacks during the school day
- Middle school students may not use backpacks during the school day without administrative approval

It shall be left to the discretion of the principal/dean of students (if principal not present) to determine whether a student meets the Harborside Dress code. In addition, any student out of dress code will be required to wear school-issued attire (**NO CALLING HOME OR CHANGING INTO SELF-SUPPLIED CLOTHING except prior to the start of the school day**) with attire returned or potentially fined and/or disciplinary action. Students late to class due to correcting dress code will be recorded as a violation and marked tardy. Adventure Education attire will be listed in camp directions/packets.

Violations of dress code will also be reflected in the student's Habits of Success grade in Crew.
