# **Update on Harborside Lottery/Results (Information Only)**

Update from Trent regarding the Lottery and the current waitlist size. Over the past years, the size of the waitlist has been declining. Many years ago, the list was over 80. Today we continue to fill all available seats, however the waitlist has declined to around 20 for middle school now.

This upcoming year will be the first year that the middle school students with the new class size from middle school to high school. Approximately 12% of the middle school students did not stay for high school, however we were able to fill those seats with the high school choice process.

In the current 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade, through normal churn of students leaving, there are approximately 20 vacant seats for these grades. Harborside is actively advertising to find any interested students in KUSD are interested in taking any of these seats. We are now looking to change to 3 sections for all high school grades 1 year earlier than anticipated.

Additional discussion around how Harborside could promote and recruit more students for the High School. Suggestions and open to being open about how to get more communication to Middle School's as there are also challenges on the Middle School's having time and being open to having Harborside come in and present.

# Update regarding KTEC Charter School and KUSD- Informational Only

There have been a few developments regarding KTEC. Harborside is the lone standing Charter School in KUSD. Over the years, the other Charter Schools and programs have not renewed, ended, or promoted to a Choice School. KTEC and Harborside were the only 2 Charters left, however KTEC had some internal troubles which resulted in them being in violation in their Charter and both KUSD and KTEC agreed to change KTEC to a Choice school.

KUSD pro-actively reached out to Harborside reassuring there is no agenda or plan for KUSD to eliminate Charters and plans to leave Harborside as a Charter School. Conversations of what would happen to Harborside in the event of it getting changed to a Choice School vs. a Charter. Harborside would not be able to be an EL school and do the programing we do and the culture we have.

Discussion around the differences between what are the differences between a Charter and a Choice School. The summary is autonomy over items like budget, staffing, curriculum, and schedules.
