Greetings Hawk Families! August is the next page on the calendar and I want to make sure that you have all the events listed on your calendar so you don't miss out on anything important. Please read through the following information below and reach out with any questions you may have.

Updates:

- Assistant Principal Search: Bullen Middle School has a new principal and it is Mr. St. Martin, former Assistant Principal here at ITHSA. We are extremely thankful for all of his hard work over the past six years here at Indian Trail and are looking forward to him doing great things for Bullen Middle School as their new leader. We are working with KUSD to find a new assistant principal and hope to be able to announce that in my August communication with all Hawk families.
- **Student Parking Lot Improvement:** Last summer the first phase of parking lot improvement started which included improvements to help drain and dry out excess water under the perimeter of the parking lot. Phase two is just starting and that will improve the interior of the parking lot. We anticipate phase three next summer which should hopefully resurface the lot. Students attending summer school should watch for barricades as they drive through the student parking lot and park in appropriate areas.
- School Improvement Planning (SIP): We will always do our very best to put staff and students in a position to learn at the highest levels. We have already met this summer to work on ways to improve our questioning and discussion techniques, improve student engagement for all students, and develop plans to improve opportunities for students in need of additional academic support. We update our goals every three years and this is year two of our most recent three-year plan. We believe in the tremendous potential we have here and will continue to work hard to get the very best out of students and staff.
- **Registration:** Registration is 100% online via the parent portal, unless you are making a change to your address. If that is the case, you will need to provide appropriate proof of residence paperwork to our guidance office. Please register and pay fees online today if you have not already done so.
