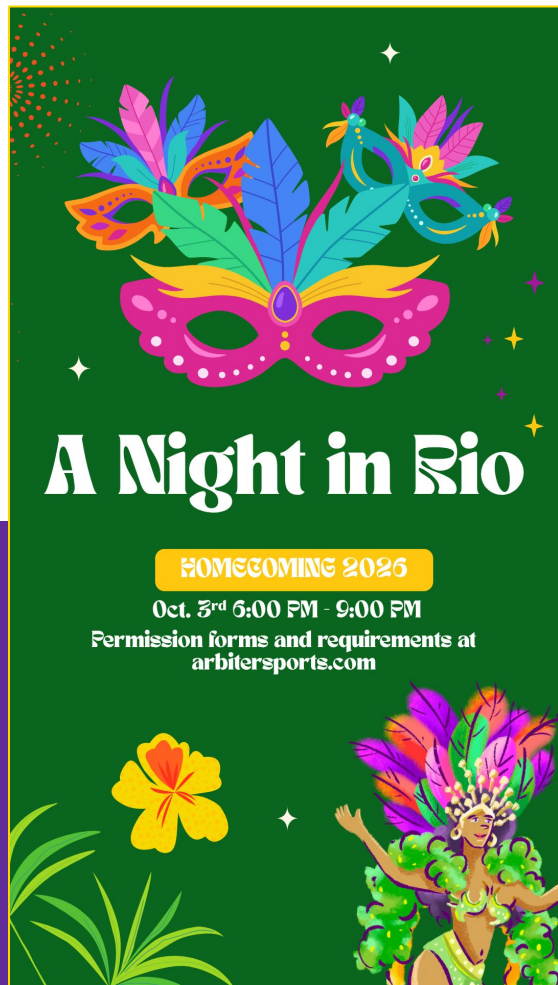

***The night of the dance, (Oct. 3rd) all guests must have a photo ID
and their ticket to enter the dance.***

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Dance attendees:

- ★ May not have any truancies on or after September 8th, 2025.
- ★ May not have more than 5 unexcused tardies (from September 8th, 2025) up to the date of the dance
- ★ May not have any suspensions this school year
- ★ Must have all detentions served by Oct. 9th, 2025

Door Decorating Contest : HAWK Time

Contest Guidelines

1. Students must produce the decorations and decorate the door.
2. The door must be decorated by **Wednesday, September 30th before Pd. 3.**
3. Nothing installed may damage the classroom door, its paint or varnish.
 - ★ No nails, tacks, or staples may be put into the door.
 - ★ All adhesives used must be FULLY removable. Please test your adhesives before using it!!!
6. Door handles MUST remain visible and operational; Door decorations may not impede the usage of the door or pose a safety hazard.
7. **Should include *the Night in the Rio* theme and Hawk Pride!**
 - *If you plan to leave your door decorations in place for more than a week, please make sure your window is visible.*

How will the contest be judged?

Each classroom door will be judged according to the following criteria:

1. Is the display Creative? Neat? Colorful? Resourceful? Eye-catching?
2. Is the door completely decorated?
3. Do the decorations fit with a Hoco theme & show Hawk Pride?
4. Does the display follow all of the school regulations and contest guidelines?

A team of faculty & administrators will be judging the doors Wednesday, September 30th. The winning classes by floor will be announced at the Pep Assembly on Thursday

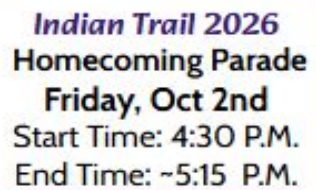
