
- Over a lifetime, the gap in earnings between those with a high school diploma and a B.A. or higher exceeds **\$1,000,000.**

Tuition and Fees
+ Room and Board
+ Transportation
+ Books & Supplies
+ Miscellaneous Living Expenses
= Cost of Attendance (COA)
