



Our longstanding tradition of submitting <u>KUDOS</u> to share great things you see happening at KTEC continues!

Has your student mentioned a Panther Pause? It is a tool used by staff to address student behaviors.

- Ensure students are being redirected in minor behaviors before they turn into referrals.
- Help students realize what proper behaviors entail.
- Allows staff to work with a student to create reasonable interventions while building a relationship.
- Provides a forum for teachers and other team members (deans, counselors & addministration) discuss how to create a plan to meet students' needs.
- Empowers teachers with a variety of strategies to help students on an individualized basis.
- Presents the opportunity for students to identify their current zone of regulation and learn to self-regulate.
- Improves communication between teachers, students, counselors, deans, and administrative team about behavioral issues.
