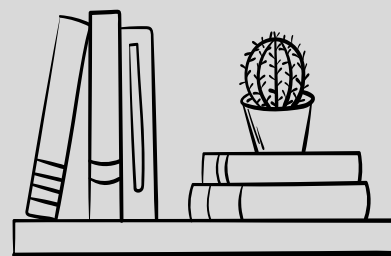




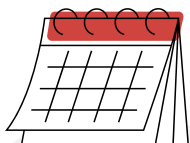

Arrival/Dismissal Update!

Hello, KTEC Families. This is Principal Creel with a brief update regarding dismissal. We are taking your feedback and continue to appreciate everyone's patience and understanding as we work towards new dismissal plans that more appropriately service our walk-up families as well as our drive-up families and addresses inclement weather conditions. This week, the administrative team formed a dismissal committee comprised of staff and members of the PTSC to address our dismissal concerns. We have developed a system that addresses the aforementioned concerns but it needs refinement, materials, and training of our staff and students before it is ready to launch. This will take time but please know we are working as fast as we can. Again, thank you to everyone who has given us grace while we work towards this. You are all greatly appreciated.

Many parents have asked about our Panther Pause?

The following is a brief description, purpose and process involved with a Panther Pause: The Panther Pause is used at KTEC as a means for the student and teacher to reflect on the student's negative behavior and to move forward in a positive direction with reasonable interventions. It ensures that the student is redirected in minor behaviors before the behaviors become referrals. The Panther Pause is also a resource used by teachers, deans, counselors, and administrators to discuss a plan to meet the student's needs using a variety of strategies.

When the student has exhibited negative behavior, the teacher and student will complete the Panther Pause together so that everyone has an understanding of the behavioral issue. The Panther Pause will be sent home with the student for a parent signature. This is to ensure the parent(s) are aware of the behavior and can follow up with the student to change the behavior. The signed Panther Pause should be returned to the teacher.

Effective with the 2024-2025 school year, KUSD is requiring all parents, volunteers, and/or chaperones to complete a background check **yearly**.
