# Getting to and from Mahone... City Buses?



Students who live east of HWY 31 will ride a city bus:

Students will be assigned a bus to ride.

It could be a shuttle bus (e.g. 4A, 4C, 3B)

It could be a regular route bus (e.g. 3, 5)

- Students will not be allowed to hop buses.
- No bus pass, not allowed on the bus.
- Replacement passes are \$2.

Takes 3-5 days for pass to come to the school  
Meantime the cost to ride the bus is \$1.50 each way

Getting your child to and from school is an important part of your child's school day. With your help we hope to make this a pleasant experience for your child and all of the other children riding with him or her to and from school. Bus stop locations are determined by the bus company and the office of transportation to create the smoothest/shortest path for the bus drivers and to pick up multiple students at one stop. Keeping the fewest stops per bus route helps your child by reducing travel time and increasing safety. It is very important your child be at their designated bus stop ten minutes prior to their scheduled time. Generally, home stops are only created for a student with special needs or if the roadway has been deemed hazardous.

### When will I see the bus on the map?

As long as the vehicle's GPS unit is working properly, the bus icon appears on the map 15 minutes before your student's route is scheduled to begin and disappears 5 minutes after the bus arrives at the destination.

### How do I track the bus?

Once you enter your student's stop into your Profile, it will automatically appear on the FirstView® map. Below is a quick explanation for each icon.

	Shows the location of your student's stop.
	Shows the location of your student's school.
	Shows the location of the vehicle (bus) and the direction of vehicle travel (arrow).
	Provides the tracking status once your student's route begins.
	Confirms the bus arrived at your student's stop and displays the time it did so. All AM stop information will drop off the map view list after noon each day. Similarly, all PM stops will drop off after midnight.
	Shows the time your student's bus arrived at the school in the morning or departed school in the afternoon.
	Refresh icon in the upper left-hand corner of the map lets you know the app is working and updating.

### Can I follow more than one stop?

Yes! Buses for all your students can be tracked with FirstView®. Using individual colors for each student, every selected stop appears on the map simultaneously for easy viewing.

### Is it possible to send notifications to my childcare provider and my work email address?

Yes! Parent app users can go to "Settings" and add up to three email addresses as "notification recipients" to get push notifications forwarded to their email.

### I need to change my student's bus stop or home address. Can I do that within the app?

No. If you have changes or questions about your student's bus stop or home address, please contact your school district office.

# Yellow and City Bus Expectations

## Kenosha Unified School Student Passenger Conduct Guidelines

1. Board and depart the bus at designated stops,
2. Exercise good conduct at bus stops,
3. Be on time at designated bus stop,
4. Wait for bus to stop before boarding,
5. Cross the street after the bus has left the bus stop,
6. Exact fare payment required; Drivers do not make change,
7. Seats may be assigned by the bus driver,
8. If seated, stay seated while the bus is in motion,
9. Keep head, hands and arms inside the bus, and to yourself. No hitting or pushing of other will be tolerated.
10. Be courteous to other passengers and the driver,
11. Do not throw anything on, at or out of the bus,
12. No eating, drinking or smoking while on the bus,
13. Vandalism will be treated as a police matter,
14. Refrain from noise that would distract the driver,
15. If seated, keep legs bags and other objects out of the aisle,
16. Follow the instructions of the bus driver or bus supervisor,
17. Possession or use of controlled substances or alcoholic beverages on buses shall not be permitted
18. Profane, degrading or threatening comments not permitted.

#5 for yellow bus riders will wait for the bus driver to signal student to cross the road.

Failure to follow these rules can result in suspension or denial of bus privileges.

Students are required to show driver their students school ID upon request from the driver. Failure to show ID can result in denial of ridership for that day.

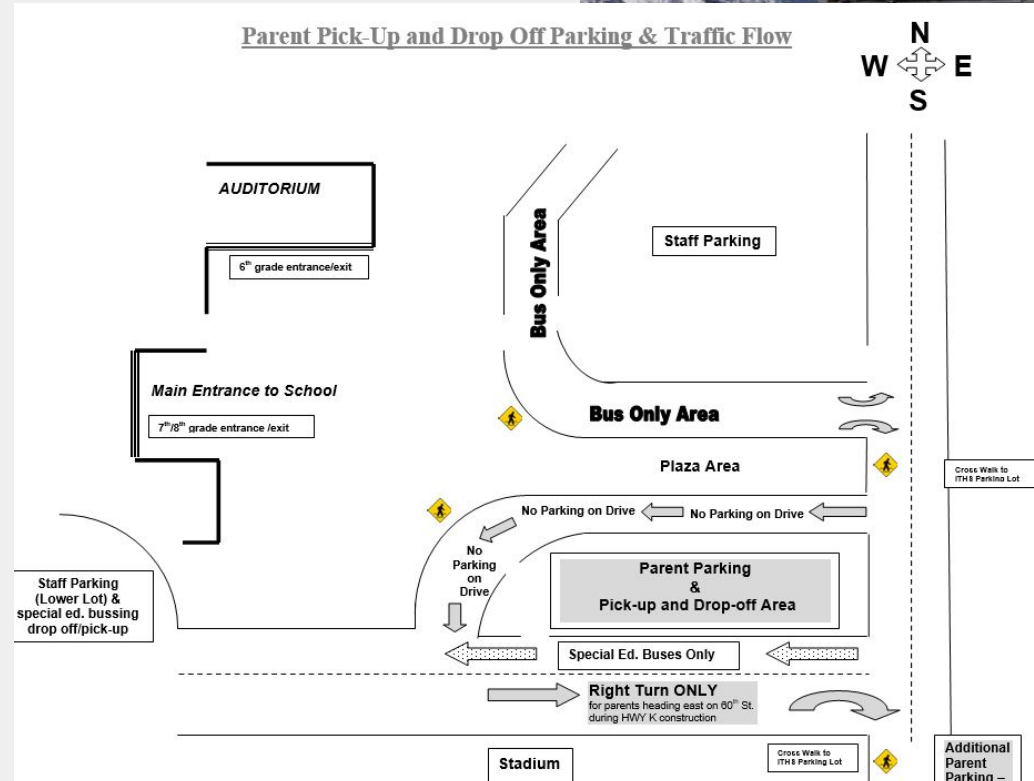


## DROPPING OFF AND PICKING UP:

# Personal Phone Calls for Students & Cell Phones

## Personal Calls for Students

- It is extremely difficult for us to deliver personal messages to individual students on a daily basis. Please make transportation/friend arrangements prior to the start of the day with your child.
- Due to high office traffic in the afternoon, no personal phone messages will be delivered after 3:15pm/2:00pm on Fridays.
- When students use the classroom phone you will see 262-359-8100. The office staff has no way of knowing where the call originated.
- All sick calls are made in the office, if your child is calling from his/her cell, they might not be sick, but just want to go home.

- **Locker access is before school, before/after lunch, after school.**

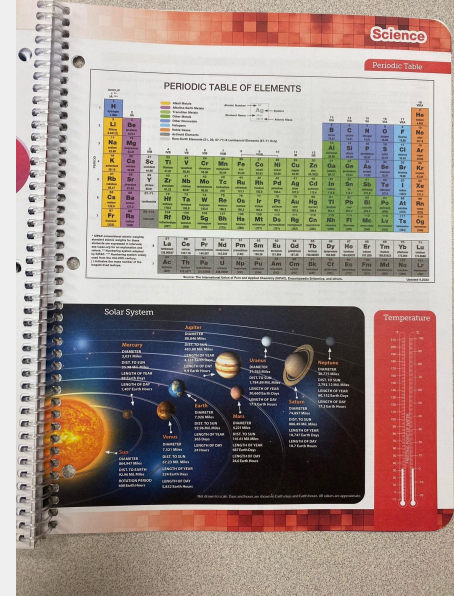
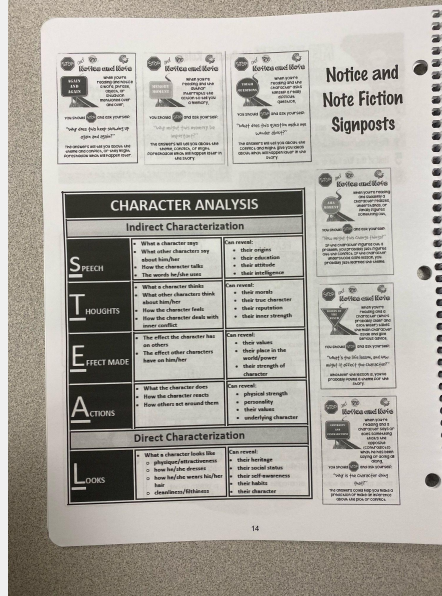
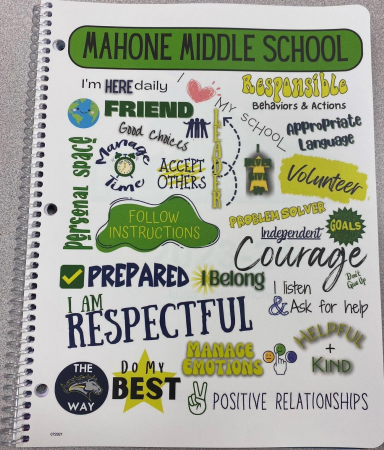

# Helping your Child be Successful!

Grades in infinite Campus are after-the-fact!

Students receive quarterly grades at mid-quarter and at the end of the quarter.

**Important to Establish a routine at home for any work completion.**

Our D.A.N. (digital assignment notebook) is in the NOW (current) as to what is happening today, what is happening at the end of the week. Use the D.A.N. to see what work your child may have to complete.

A+	= 98-100%
A	= 93-97%
A-	= 90-92%
B+	= 86-89%

We do not give extra-credit to improve a poor grade. We want students to do it correctly the first time.

**Parents and students can see grades in Infinite Campus through the Parent or Student Portals.**

P = Practice Makes up less than 20% of the total grade.

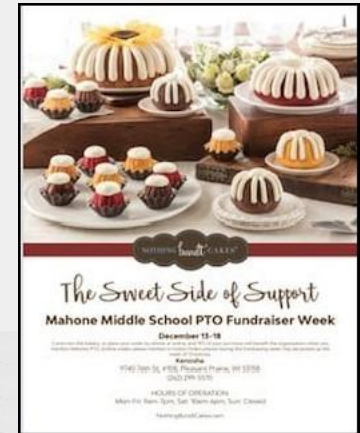
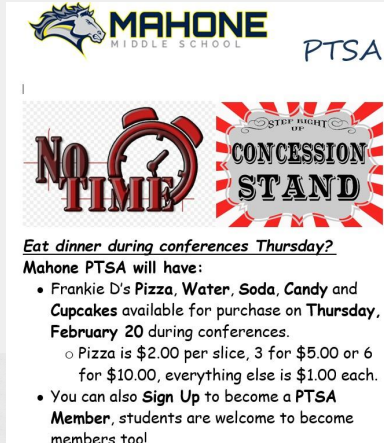
