Dear Reuther Parents, Guardians and Graduating Seniors:

Congratulations Class of 2021! Despite a global pandemic, our seniors have made it to the final weeks of their high school careers. This letter includes important information about our Seniors' final days and graduation. Please read it carefully and keep it for future reference.

Cap and Gown Information: If you are planning on participating in the graduation ceremony, you must order a cap and gown from jostens.com. The final day to order is this Friday, April 30, 2021. Information about pick up of your cap and gown will be announced soon.

Community Service Hours: All seniors are expected to complete ten hours of community service. Please turn in your signed paperwork to Missy Werner or Jane DeCesaro in the Guidance Office.

Senior Final Exams: Senior final exams will take place on Wednesday, May 26.

Last Day for Seniors: The last day for seniors is Wednesday, May 26. This date was changed in September and is listed incorrectly on the district calendar.

Chromebook and Textbook Return (Seniors only): All seniors will need to return all Chromebooks, textbooks and library materials and may do so Wednesday, May 26 through Friday, May 28. More information will be sent.

Graduation: In order to safely host graduation for our seniors, our ceremony will be held outdoors this year. The Reuther graduation ceremony will be held on Saturday, June 5 (Rain date Saturday, June 12) at 2:00 p.m. at Jaskwhich Field (Indian Trail football stadium, 6800 60th Street).

Tickets: Due to social distancing guidelines, each graduate will be permitted to invite four guests to the ceremony. Extra tickets may be requested in writing to Mrs. Jane DeCesaro (jdecesar@kusd.edu) and we will do our best to accommodate your requests.

If you are in need of handicapped parking, special needs seating or a hearing impaired interpreter, please contact Jane DeCesaro at jdecesar@kusd.edu or at 262-359-6134.

Rehearsal: Students participating in the graduation rehearsal are expected to attend our rehearsal which begins at Jaskwhich Field at 1:00 p.m. on Friday, June 4th. Rehearsal should last approximately one hour. If you work, remember to ask off for both Friday and Saturday afternoon!

Graduation Day Ceremony:

- Graduates need to report to Mahone Middle School no later than 1:00 pm
- Families may park in the northern Mahone parking lot or the Indian Trail parking lot. Please do not park in the circular drive as that is reserved for emergency vehicles

- Entrance into the stadium is by ticket only
- Masks are required for all guests 5 and older
- The ceremony will begin at 2:00 p.m. sharp
- The Reuther Graduation Ceremony will be broadcast live via [youtube.com/kenoshaschools](https://www.youtube.com/kenoshaschools) as well as local cable Channel 20
- Lifetouch will be taking a group photo of our graduations. They will also take photos of the ceremony and of the graduates as they cross the stage and with their diploma
- Graduates will receive their diplomas immediately after the ceremony at the ticket booth; parents will meet graduates in the area directly north of the grandstands after the ceremony
