



BRYANT & STRATTON COLLEGE – EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Application Deadline: March ¹⁶₁, 2018

The value of the scholarship is up to **\$35,000** or no more than \$7,000 per semester. Eligibility for the scholarship does not exceed five semesters. In order to receive the scholarship, a student must be enrolled at Bryant & Stratton College on a full-time basis for the Fall 2018 semester by the admissions deadline set by the college.

Students at Kenosha Unified High Schools who will be graduating in January 2018 or June 2018 must complete this application and submit to their designated school counselor by **March 1st, 2018**. Applicants do not need to be accepted to Bryant & Stratton by the scholarship deadline. Applicants should see their school counselor if they have questions. Criteria for Eligibility:

- Applicant must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA or higher
- Applicant must submit a 1-2 page typed essay on his/her future career goals or aspirations

1. Complete this application form as accurately as possible.
2. Attach the following materials:
 - a. Bryant & Stratton Inquiry Form (Attached to Application)
 - b. Essay on Future Career Goals or Aspirations (1-2 page typed)
 - c. Transcript Showing Cumulative GPA of 3.0 Minimum (with all Career & Technical Education courses related to post-secondary program of study highlighted)
3. Return the completed form and attachments to your high school counselor no later than **Friday February 16th** to be considered.
