Who selects winners, and how?	<p>The Club will select winner(s) based on answer to this essay topic: <i>“Your memoir has just become an international bestseller. What does the back cover of the book say about you?”</i> The typed essay should be no longer than one page.</p>	
Criteria/Restrictions: (verification will be required for each)	<p>Applicant must:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be a resident of Kenosha County 2. Be a student with learning disabilities documented in an IEP, or with documented physical disabilities 3. Be a high school senior, graduating from a Kenosha County high school with a minimum 3.0 cumulative gpa 4. Be accepted as a full-time student at an accredited institution of higher education 5. Maintain at least a 2.25 gpa after the first term in order for the scholarship to be renewed for the next term, until the first calendar year is ended and the scholarship exhausted <p><i>Members or relatives of members of the Kiwanis Club of Kenosha Breakfast are not eligible for the scholarship.</i></p>
