The P.E.O. STAR Scholarship program provides a \$2500 award to high school senior women who wish to pursue a post-secondary education. *Kenosha's Chapter BO of the P.E.O. sisterhood has the opportunity to recommend one female high school senior for a STAR Scholarship. Last year P.E.O. awarded \$2500 scholarships to 900 young women, totaling 2.25 million dollars. We are hoping that one of this year's recipients will be from the Kenosha area.*

Student Criteria for Eligibility:

1. Exhibits excellence in leadership, extracurricular activities (2 years or more), community service (2 years or more), academics and potential for future success.
2. A graduating senior (Class of 2023), age 20 years of age or under by the application deadline of October 15.
3. In the final academic year (senior year) of secondary education at time of application deadline.
4. Minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
5. Citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States or Canada.
6. Plans to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution in the United States or Canada full-time or part-time in the fall of the academic year following her high school graduation.
7. Recommended by a P.E.O. chapter.
