About Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity

The Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity is best known as the Boulé, a Greek term meaning “council of noblemen.”

Founded in 1904, Sigma Pi Phi is the oldest Greek –letter organization comprised primarily of African-American men. The Boulé has more than 5,000 members and 119 chapters throughout the United States and the Caribbean. Its membership consists of some of the most accomplished, affluent and influential men- leaders who are making lasting contributions to their communities, our society and the world.

Criterion for Applicants

The distribution of funds will be administered by the Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity Scholarship Committee which will send a scholarship check to the college/university. The check will be issued in the name of the student. Should the student fail to attend the school the check is to be returned to the Sigma Pi Phi Fraternity Scholarship Committee.

TO QUALIFY EACH APPLICANT MUST:

- Be a male high school senior of African American or African descent with a 3.00 cum GPA or higher.
- Submit an application, transcript, current class schedule and two letters of recommendation from a teacher, official church representative and or community leader.
- Submit 500 word essay on “How can obtaining a college education effect the black community?” or “How can incorporating selfless service into your daily life effect the current and future state of the black community?”
- Scholarship recipients **MUST** be present at the awards ceremony **Saturday, June 5, 2021**
- Have completed high school and be enrolled in a college/ university.
- Have maintained a 3.00 GPA for the duration of the scholarship.
- Show proof of acceptance to a qualifying college/university.
- Use funds for tuition, room and board, laboratory fees or materials required for study at the college/ university they attend. Checks will be made out to the two scholarship recipients in the amount of **\$1,000.00** each upon proof of college acceptance.
- Be scholarly, exhibit moral character and leadership abilities.
- Volunteer time and talent back to the community that is supporting him.
- Keep in touch with the fraternity regarding their progress or lack of it in college.
- Understand that any violations or infractions of the rules established by the college/ university as well as the funding agency will result in forfeiture of eligibility to receive further funds. Any funds remaining upon withdrawal from the college or university must be returned to the funding agency within 90 days.
