**Eligibility:**

1. Applicant must be a senior member of the Tremper PTSA as of November 21, 2018 (and graduating from Tremper High School in 2019).
2. Applicant must attend a post-secondary educational institution in the fall term of 2019.
3. **The scholarship application must be received in the PTSA mailbox on or before 3:00 p.m. on May 1, 2019.**
  - a. The PTSA mailbox is in the Tremper High School Main Office.

## Tremper PTSA Scholarship

1. Applicant must be a senior member of the Tremper PTSA as of November 21, 2018 (*and graduating from Tremper May of 2019*). Will be attending a post-secondary educational institution in the fall term of 2019.
2. Each applicant for the Tremper PTSA Scholarship is asked to write two short essays, each no greater than 300 words in length. Please refer to the essay specifications below.
3. **Criteria:** The essays will be evaluated on quality, clarity, and content.
  - a. Describe the value of parents, teachers, and students working together.
  - b. Describe a role model/mentor in your life, and how that person has been an influence on your future goals and career choice. Please do not list this person by name or distinguishing title, because we want to keep the application anonymous. (For example, don't say: "My mentor is my mother, Mary Smith, President of the Kenosha Women's Club..." Instead say: "*My mentor is my mother, who is active in local organizations...*").

### **Essay Specifications:**

1. The essay must be typed using a 12-point font.
2. Length: **300 words or less per essay.**
3. **Double spaced.**
4. **Three (3) copies** of each essay must be submitted in an envelope to the PTSA mailbox in the school main office, with only your student ID number on the outside.
5. **Include only your Tremper Student ID number as identification on each copy of the essays.** *If your name appears on the essays or the outside envelope, it will be disqualified. This will ensure a blind judging of the applications.*
6. All **scholarship applications must be submitted by 3pm on Monday, May 1, 2019.**
7. **Scholarships will be awarded at the Tremper Senior Honors Convocation on Thursday, May 23, 2019.**
8. Payment of the scholarship will be made directly to the winner's school after proof of successful completion of his/her first college semester and proof of registration for the second college semester is received.
  - a. The winning students will be required to include their Student ID number, Bursars office contact address and phone number (for confirmation on how payment should be submitted to the school).
