Mary D. Bradford dedicated 45 years of her life to classroom education and was the FIRST WOMAN to become the superintendent of schools in Kenosha in 1903. She was the first woman in the state of Wisconsin to hold this title. Before she retired in 1921 she started the first kindergarten in Kenosha. Also, she was one of the founders of the Woman's Club of Kenosha.

The GFWC Woman's Club of Kenosha is offering a \$1,000 scholarship to a senior high school woman residing in Kenosha County, graduating in May or June of 2020 and will be attending **full-time, a four year degree granting institution of higher learning to pursue a degree in classroom teaching.**

Academic achievement, career orientation, financial need and character are the primary criteria used to evaluate each applicant. An application form explaining the criteria is enclosed and we hope your counseling staff will make this information available to the students.

Applications will be accepted between February 1, 2020 and March 15, 2020. The Woman's Club will notify the winner in April. The recipient will be honored at the Woman's Club's closing luncheon on June 3, 2020.

The winner will receive her check upon formal verification of enrollment from the registrar's office of the college/university containing the official registrar's seal.
