### What to bring on testing days:

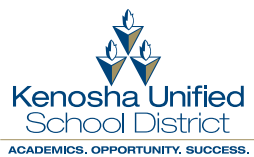
- Picture identification (school ID or driver's license)
- Two #2 pencils with erasers (not mechanical)
- Calculator (personal calculators must be pre-approved)
- Snack (during break only)

### What **NOT** to bring on testing days:

- Cellphones or other electronic devices
- Watches
- Scratch paper
- Notes
- Reading materials

## NO COST TO PARENTS OR STUDENTS

ACT with Writing scores can be used by students for college enrollment, scholarships and NCAA eligibility requirements. Scores can be sent to a maximum of four colleges based on the student's choice. These colleges must be self-identified on the ACT answer sheet. Scores also will be mailed directly to the home address indicated on the ACT answer sheet 4-6 weeks after testing.
