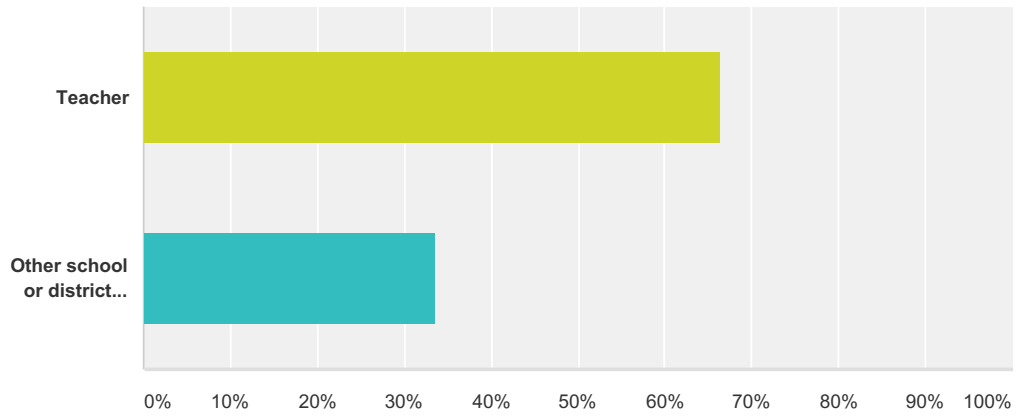


Q1 Which of the following best describes you?

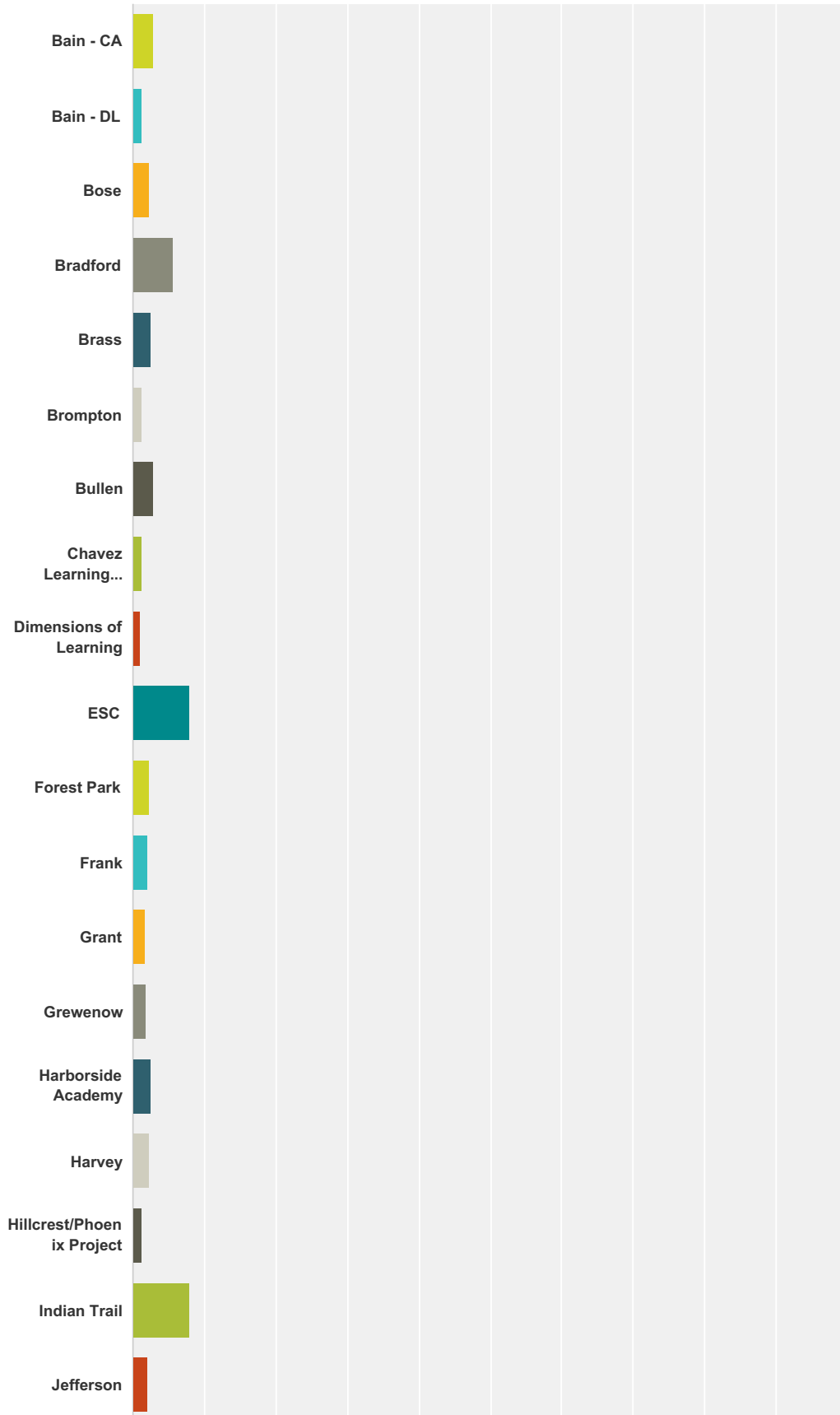

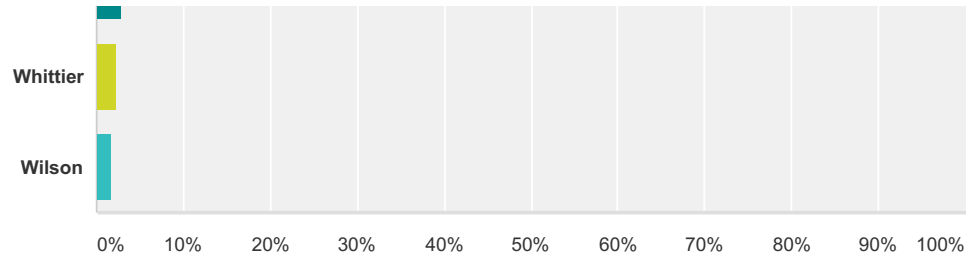

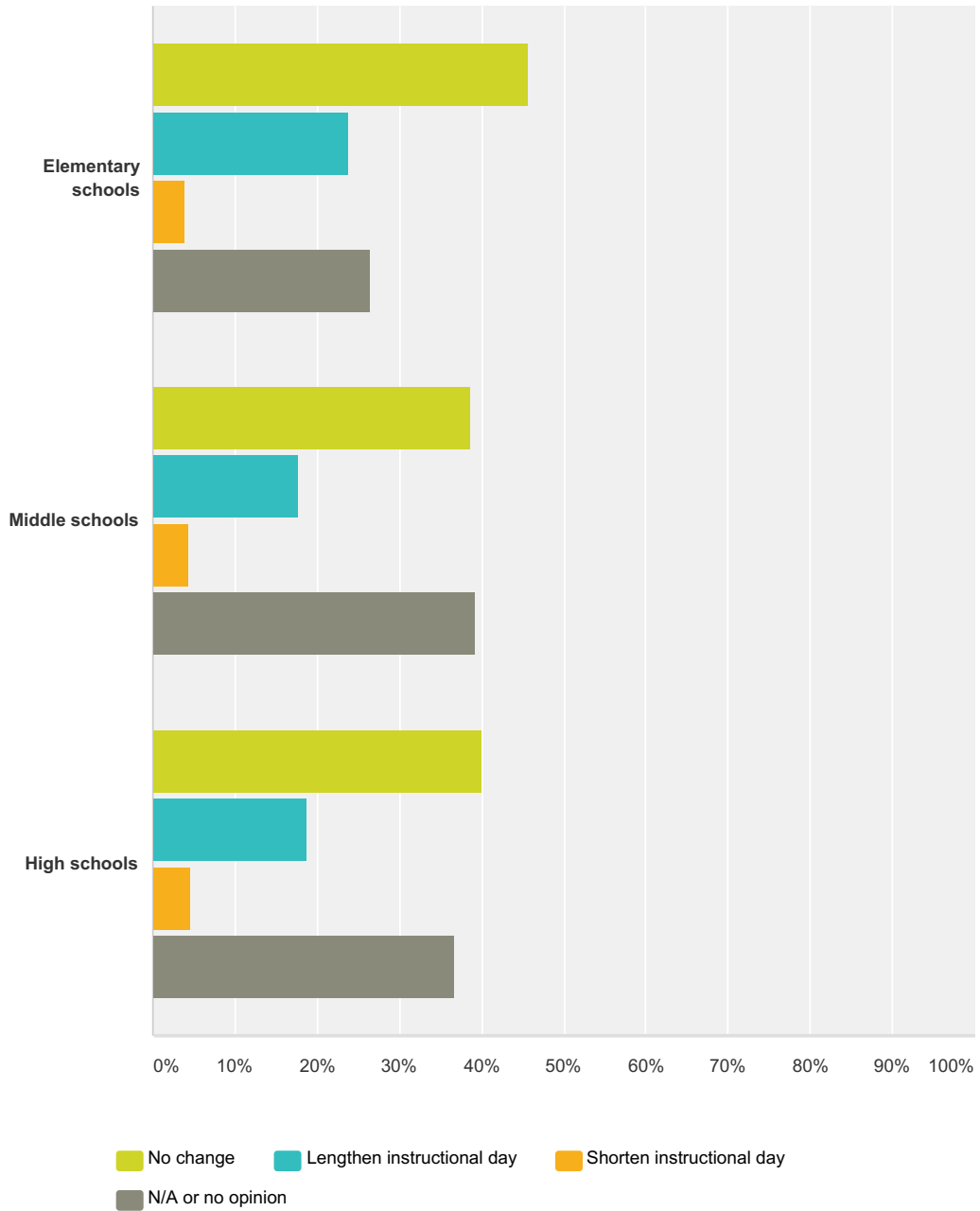

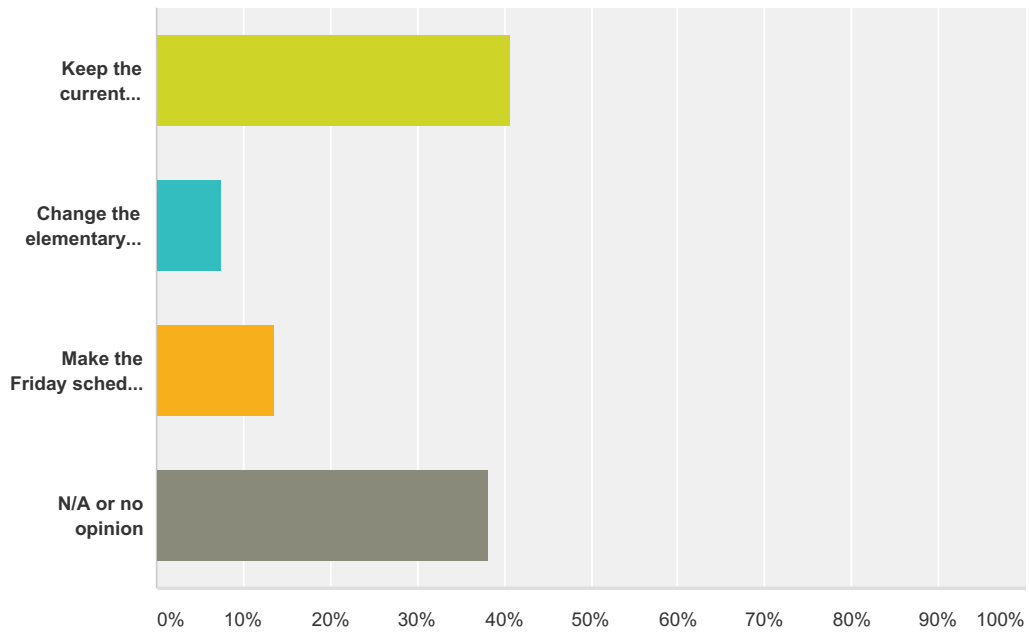

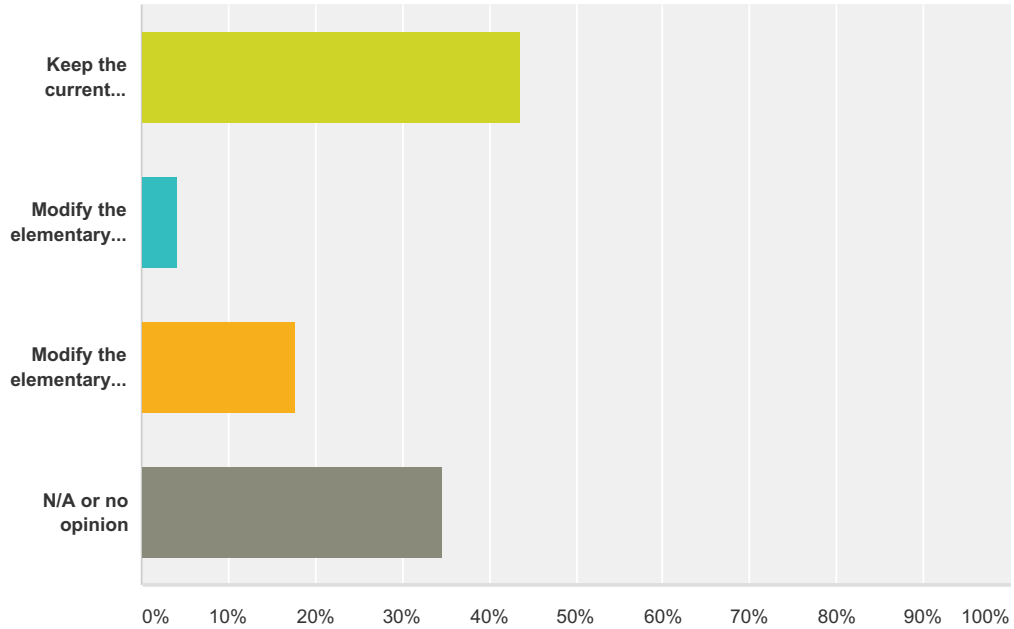

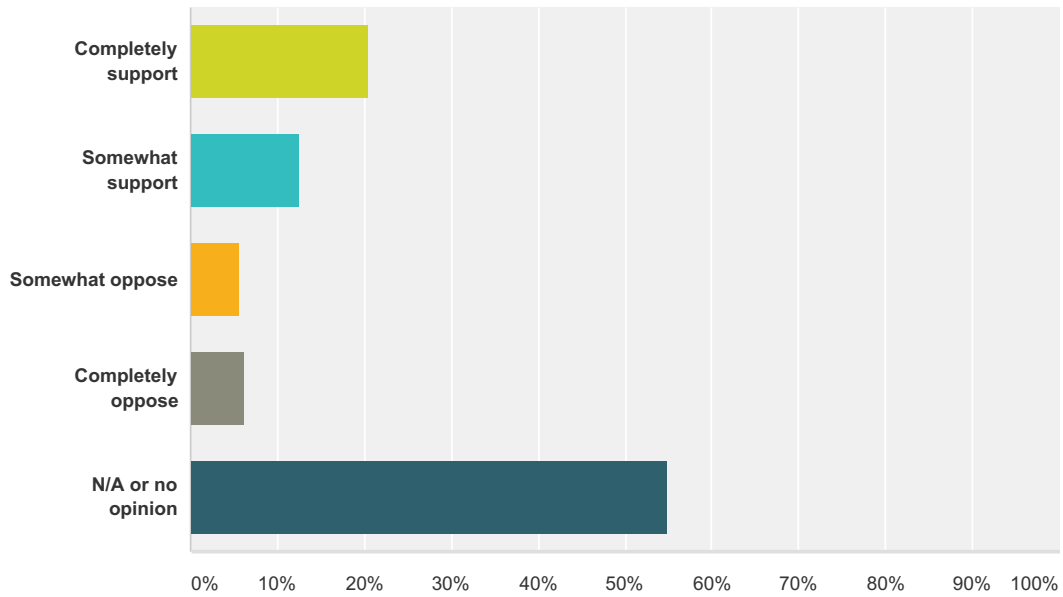

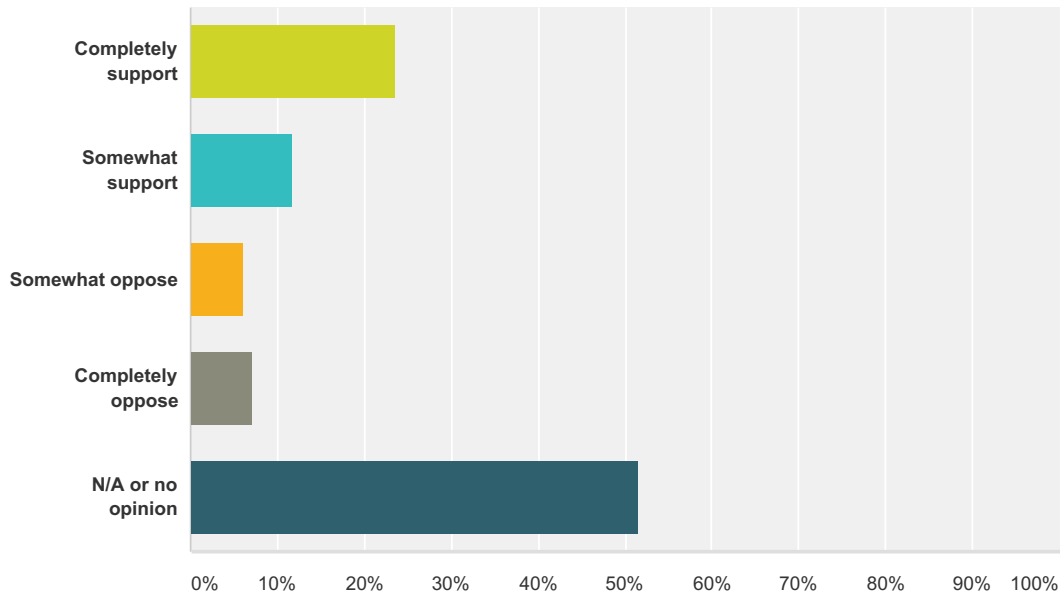

Q8 High Schools Please select your level of support for/opposition to the 60 minute early release on Fridays for high schools.

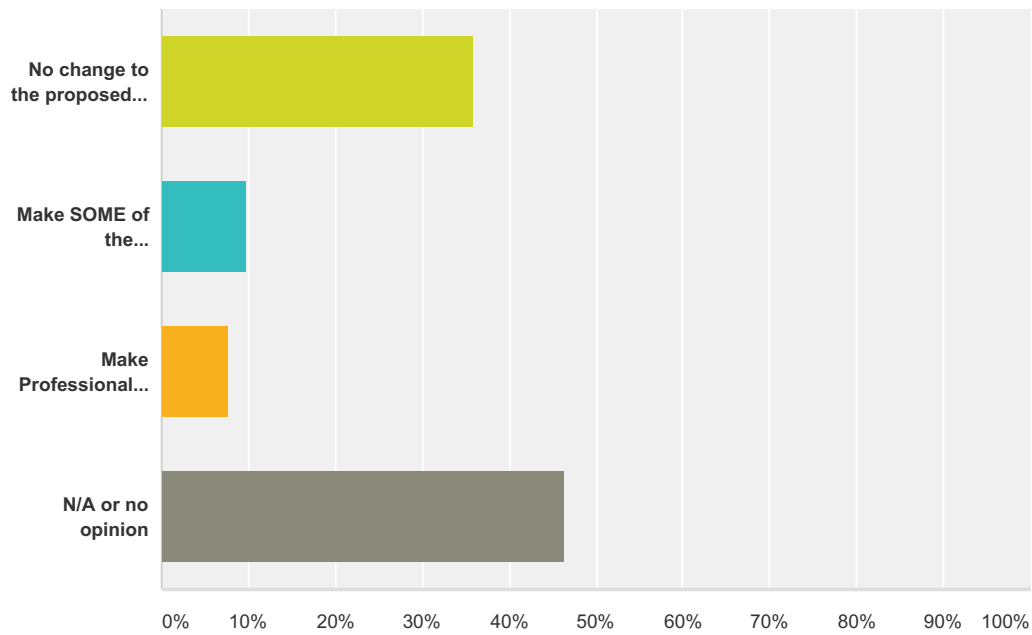

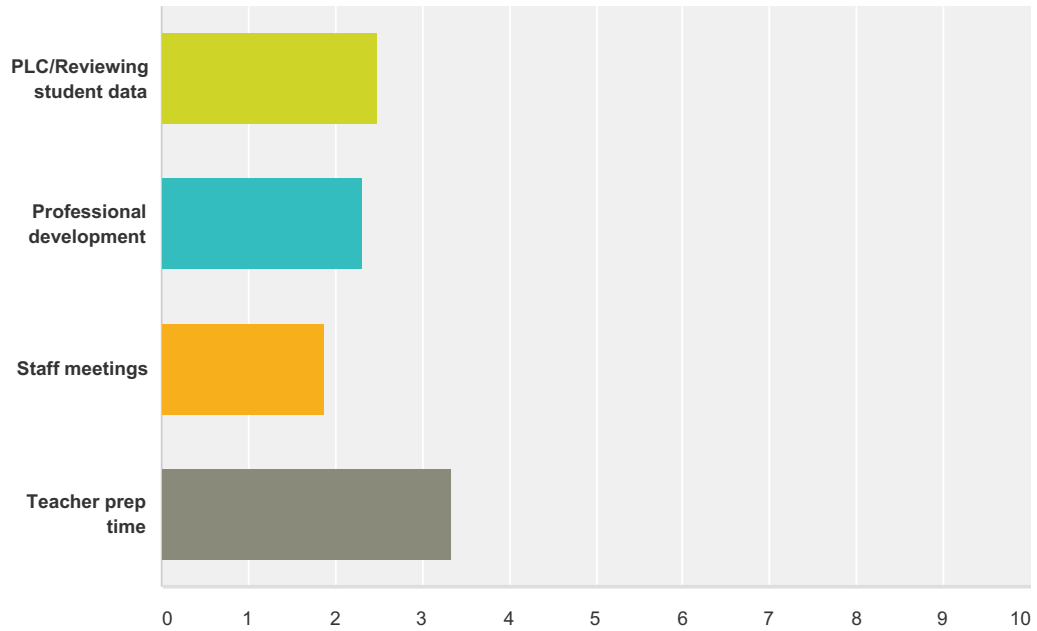

How would you prioritize this non-instructional time? *1 is the most important to you and 4 is the least important

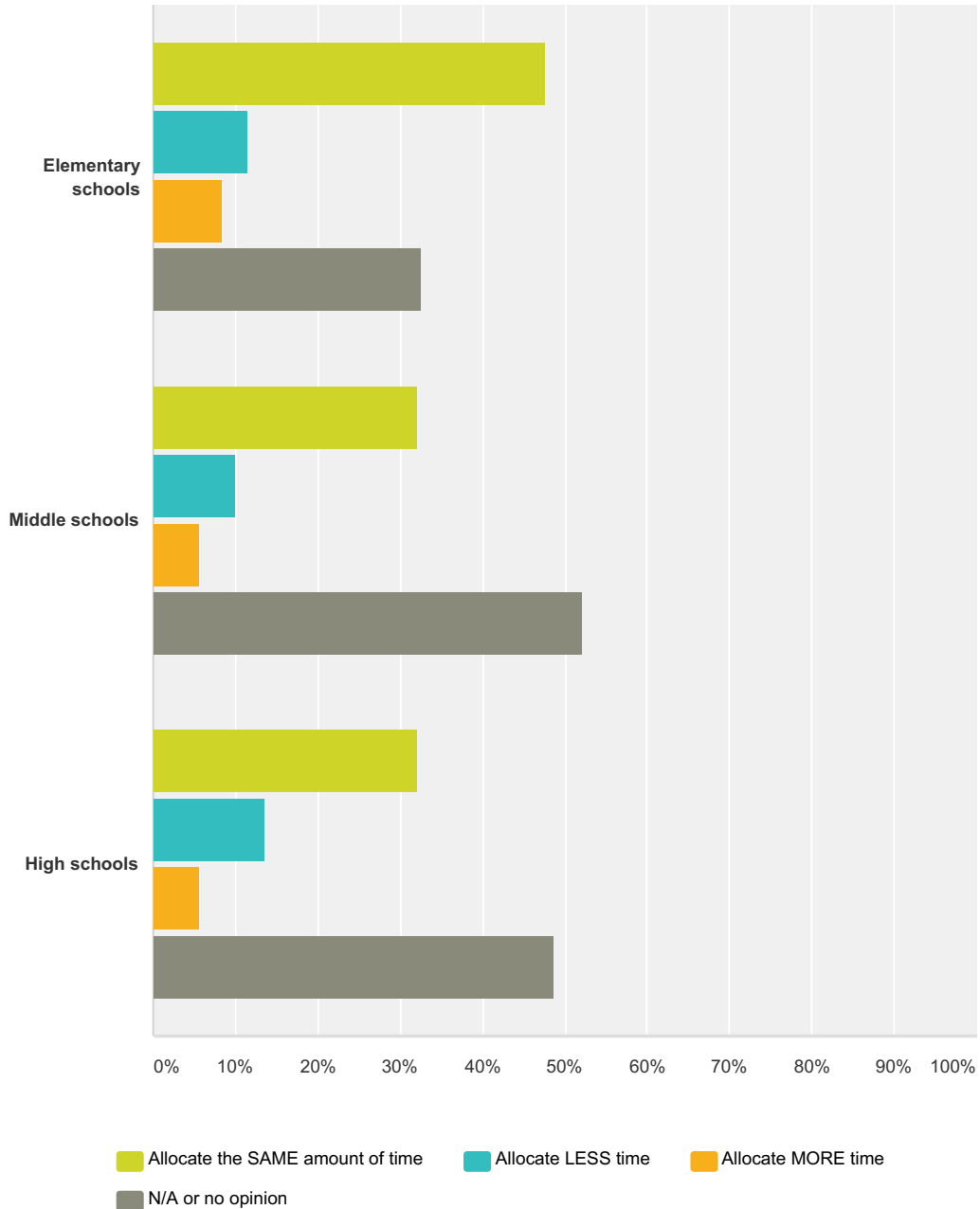

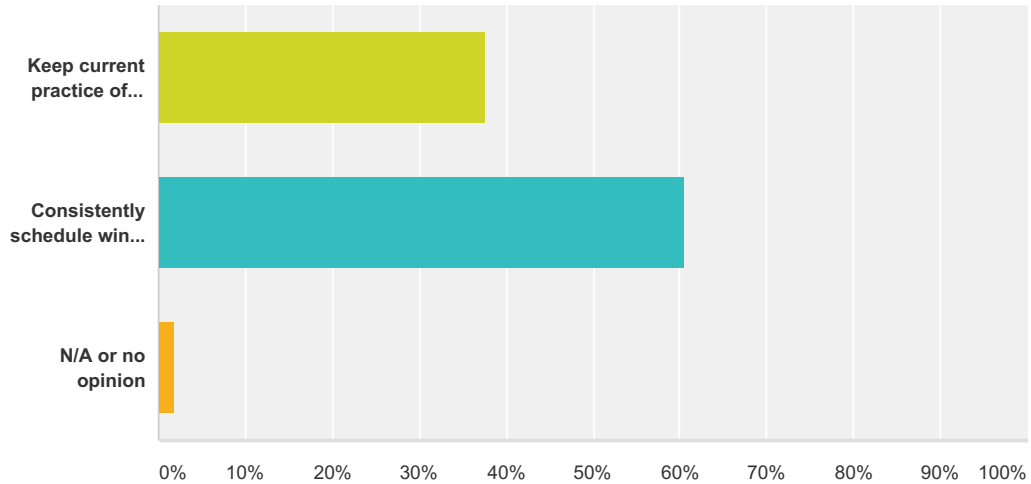

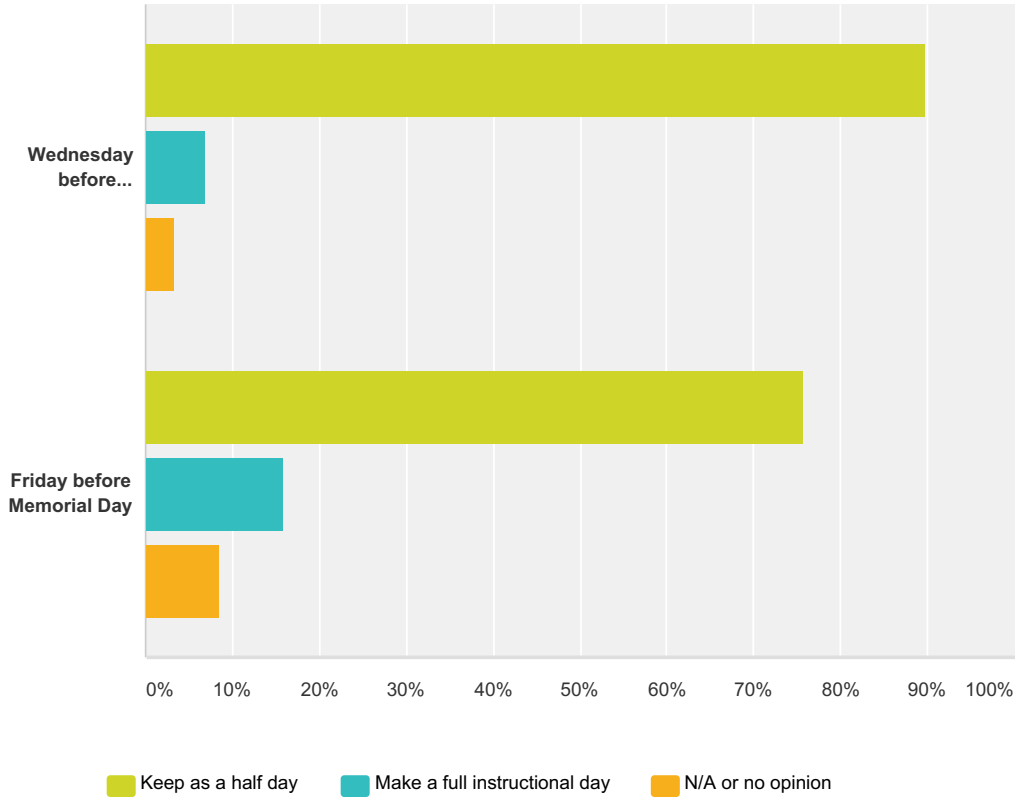

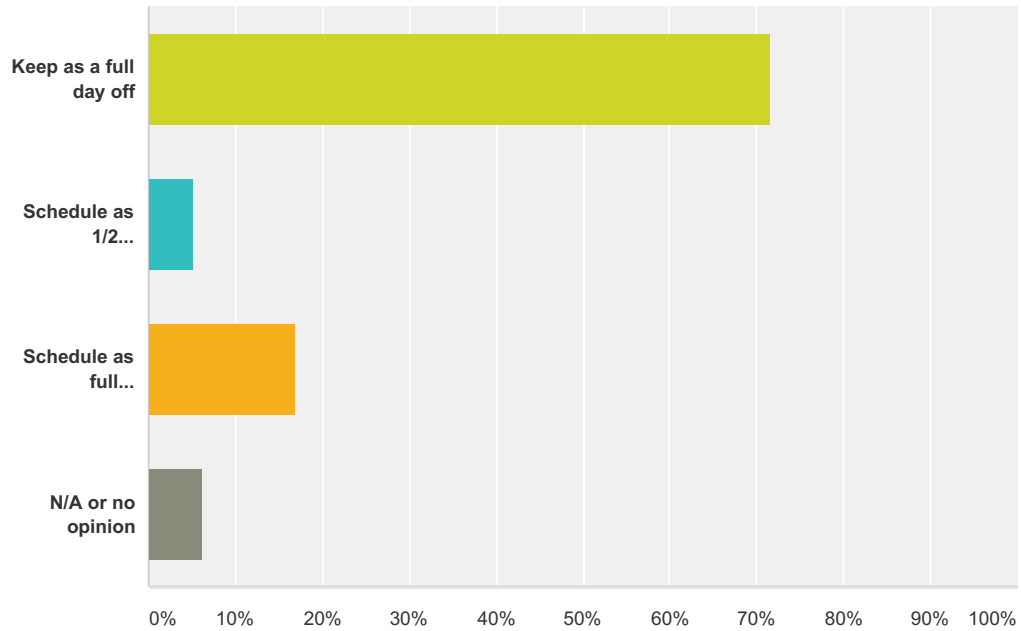
