Want to become a certified **Lifeguard?**

Ages 15 and Up Needed for Summer Jobs!

- The American Red Cross lifeguard training and certification are imperative to the process of getting hired on as an official Red Cross lifeguard. Our detailed training includes both testing of hands-on skills as well as comprehension on written tests. The certification, which includes First Aid, CPR and AED training, is valid for two years upon completion and is accepted nationwide. The American Red Cross is the most respected source for training and certification of this kind.

Prerequisites for lifeguard training include:

- Students must attend & pass 1 pre-course swimming skills test day listed below prior to taking the lifeguarding course. Indicate which day you will attend during your registration.

Pre-course Swimming skills test:

4:00 pm, Monday, June 14 or Thursday, June 17

Full Lifeguarding Course

- This course is a Blended format, 7 hours Online & 20 hours Traditional in-person (The Online course must be completed prior to beginning the in-person classes)
