WOMEN’S VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE - FALL 2018

*NOTE:* Recreation Department Registration Hours: 7:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M.

The Department of Recreation will offer Women’s Volleyball Leagues for women 16 years of age or older. The **Power Leagues** will play on **Monday**, beginning on **August 20**, at **Mahone Middle School** from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. for a period of 10 weeks. The **Recreation Leagues** will play on **Tuesday** at **Lance Middle School** beginning **August 21** and **Wednesday** at **Lance** beginning on **Wednesday, August 22** from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m. for a period of 10 weeks.

Registration for the team must be made at the Department of Recreation, 2717-67th Street, starting on **Monday, July 23, 2018**. An individual may sign up her team only. A player may play in more than one volleyball league, but only one league per night.

- NEW SIGN UP PROCEDURE -

Teams signing up for the **fall leagues** will have the **opportunity to reserve the same night & school spot** for the spring volleyball session. All teams choosing to reserve their spot will have a one (1) day priority sign-up in spring. If not signed up by 3:30 p.m. on the designated priority sign-up day, team will forfeit its reserved spot for spring session (**the designated day will be Monday, January 14, 2019**). This procedure will only be offered for spring sign-up, and only managers will receive the spring information. **Fall sign-up will remain as in the past, first come first serve basis**. This procedure will give everyone an equitable chance once a year to register for leagues & also will eliminate registration lines in the cold winter months.

The minimum number of players on a team is six and maximum is eight players. All **participants must have an address; a post office box address will not be accepted**. No members of any school women’s volleyball teams are eligible to play in the program. The program will be limited to eight teams in each league.

**NOTE:** *Volleyball games are cancelled when Kenosha Unified announces closure due to extreme weather conditions (snow or sustained wind chill minus 34 or sustained temperature of minus 20) and no children report. Volleyball games will also be cancelled when afterschool programs are cancelled due to extreme weather conditions. Volleyball games will not be rescheduled when the Kenosha Unified School District #1 calls them off because of weather.*

Members will be required to provide their own personal towels for shower purposes and appropriate gym garments for playing. Soft-soled tennis or gym shoes are required on the gym floor.
