

POLICY 3522
MILK PROGRAM

The School Board may make additional milk available to students participating in the school nutrition programs. Also, milk may be made available to students who do not participate in the school lunch program and may be made available at other times to elementary students as determined by the Board.

The District shall purchase milk free from synthetic bovine growth hormone (rBGH) if it does not jeopardize federal subsidies that the District receives to offset the cost of school meals.

When milk is made available to students who do not participate in the school nutrition programs or is made available at times other than meal periods, an established fee shall be charged for the milk.
