Pursuant to a call by the President, the School Board of the Kenosha Unified School District has scheduled a special school board meeting on Wednesday, September 25, 2019, at 5:30 P.M. in the ESC Boardroom located at 3600-52nd Street, Kenosha for a contemplated motion to adjourn into executive (closed) session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Sections 19.85(1)(a) to deliberate concerning a case which was the subject of a quasi-judicial hearing before the Board, and (b) to consider the dismissal or discipline of any public employee, the investigation of charges against such person, and the taking of formal action on any such matter.

The purpose of meeting is for considering and deliberating over the administration's recommendation to terminate the employment of a professional staff member and the response, if any, by the professional staff member and the professional staff member's representatives.

**Please note that the public employee, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 19.85(1)(b), has the right to request that a portion of this matter be addressed in open session. It is possible that the Board's discussion, consideration, and action concerning the administration's recommendation to terminate the employment of a professional staff member and the response, if any, by the professional staff member and the professional staff member's representatives, may be conducted in open session. However, a decision to conduct this portion of the meeting in open session will not affect the Board's ability to deliberate in closed session pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes Section 19.85(1)(a).
