

## OUR PROGRAM

The Kenosha eSchool Elementary program will consist of a blended model with a majority of learning constituting student-led asynchronous learning mixed with a few synchronous requirements each week. In fact, approximately 90% of the work will be asynchronous and 10% synchronous.

Each week, students will be required to attend a virtual face-to-face online advisory period with instructors. During this time, instructors will work on team building and other soft skills with students. Instructors are also available for support during office hours.


In addition, students will be required to attend two other sessions with classmates to discuss math skills and English skills. This is traditionally known as blended instruction (having both asynchronous work and synchronous work).

## WHY CHOOSE US?

KUSD has expanded its eSchool offerings to include grades K-5. Kenosha eSchool will utilize Florida Virtual School (FLVS) curriculum that will allow elementary students to navigate modules autonomously without constant interaction. While this format requires a considerable amount of parental involvement, it also allows students to work at their own pace.

Instructors will be available to provide support where needed, but will not lead instruction outside of scheduled synchronous times. Students will have access to instructors' cell phones, e-mail and Zoom hours to make contact with questions or concerns as needed.

As the work is primarily done asynchronously, students and parents may work during hours that suit their varying schedules. There also will be some synchronous interaction from time-to-time. Families are also expected to maintain pacing guides and meet all other academic requirements.

## ADMISSIONS OPEN FOR 2022 - 2023

Families must apply at [kUSD.edu/eschool](https://kUSD.edu/eschool). If applications exceed the number of allotted spots for Kenosha eSchool, a lottery will be implemented. Families that are accepted are making a one-year commitment to Kenosha eSchool and will not be allowed to exit early because staffing is based on enrollment numbers. For this reason we ask that you pay close attention to how eSchool works before making a decision to apply.
