Kenosha County Public Health would like to extend our asthma education services to your family to provide ways to help keep your child's asthma under control and give them the best opportunity for a healthy school year.

This program is **FREE** and offered to those with poorly controlled asthma who have experienced any of the following:

- Emergency room or urgent care visits for asthma attacks
- Hospital stays for asthma
- Missed school or workdays due to asthma attacks
- Repeated asthma attacks and/or symptoms within the last 4 weeks

This program will help you and your child:

- Learn more about asthma, including medications that help with asthma
- Identify and reduce things in your home that may cause asthma problems
- Reduce the amount of times asthma symptoms cause problems
- Make sure your school has the right information to help manage your child's asthma while at school

*Participants are gifted a kit of asthma-friendly cleaning supplies upon completion of the Asthma Care Program!*
