# Community Engagement Methodology

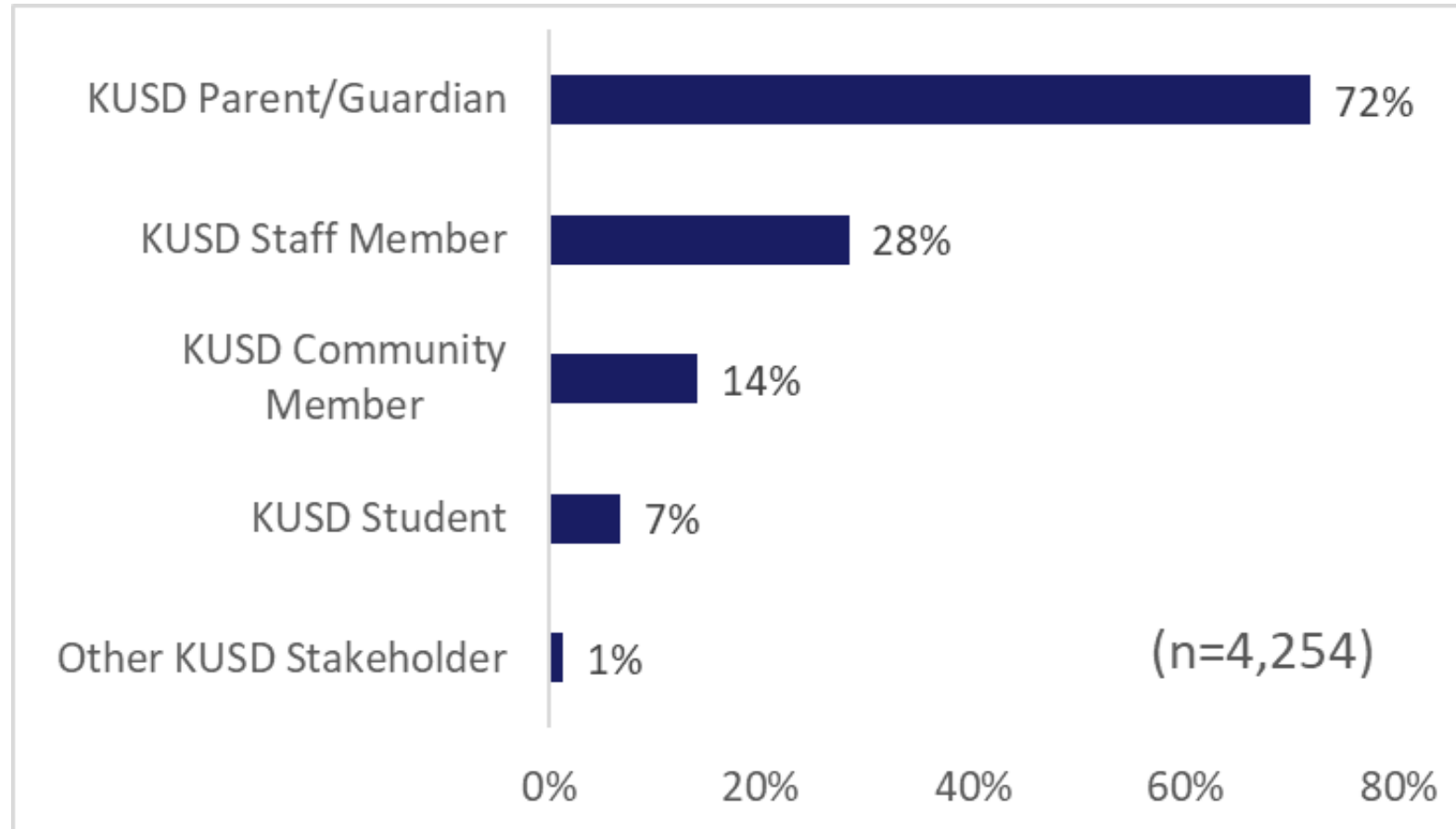
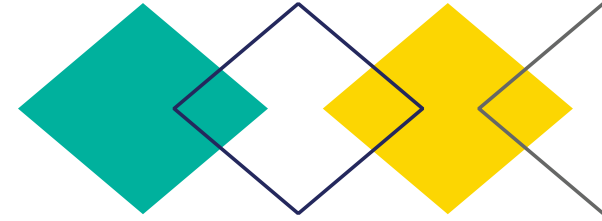


Community meetings were held on:

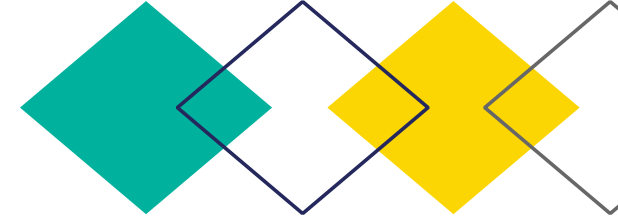
- Tuesday, October 17

  - Indian Trail High School and Academy – 147 attendees
- Wednesday, October 18
  - Tremper High School – 70 attendees
  - Reuther Central High School – 30 attendees
- Wednesday, October 25
  - Bullen Middle School – 67 attendees

The online survey was announced in community meetings and posted on the District website. Parents, students, employees, and community stakeholders were encouraged to participate in the survey to provide input about the rightsizing process. More than 4,000 valid responses were received (4,061). Results of the community meeting and survey feedback are presented in the aggregate.

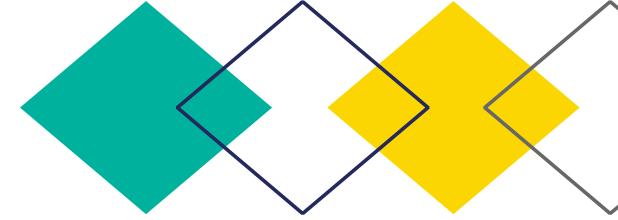

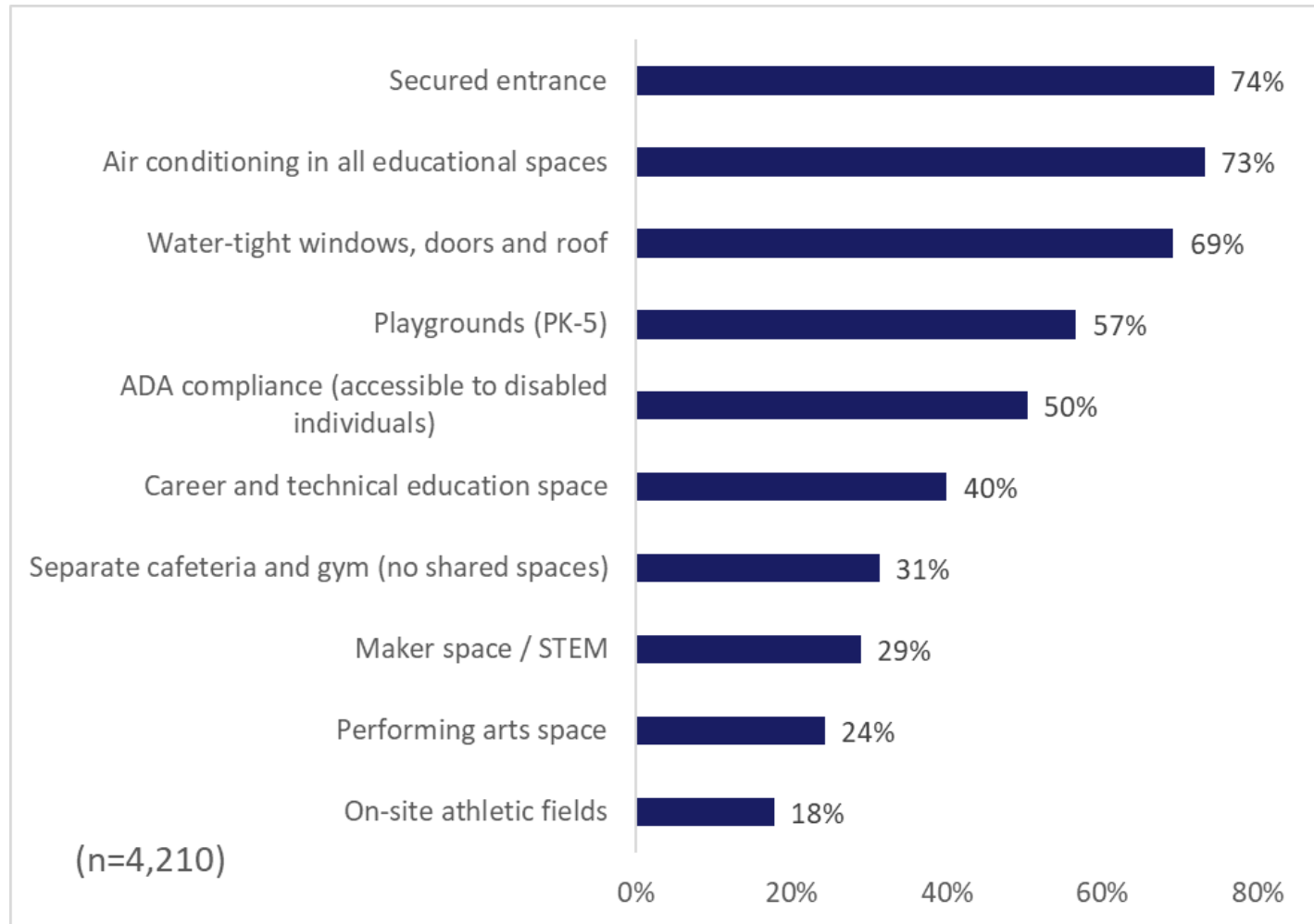
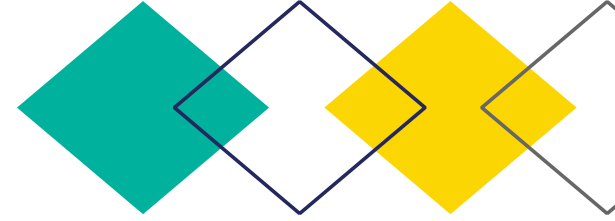
# What rightsizing objectives are MOST important to you?



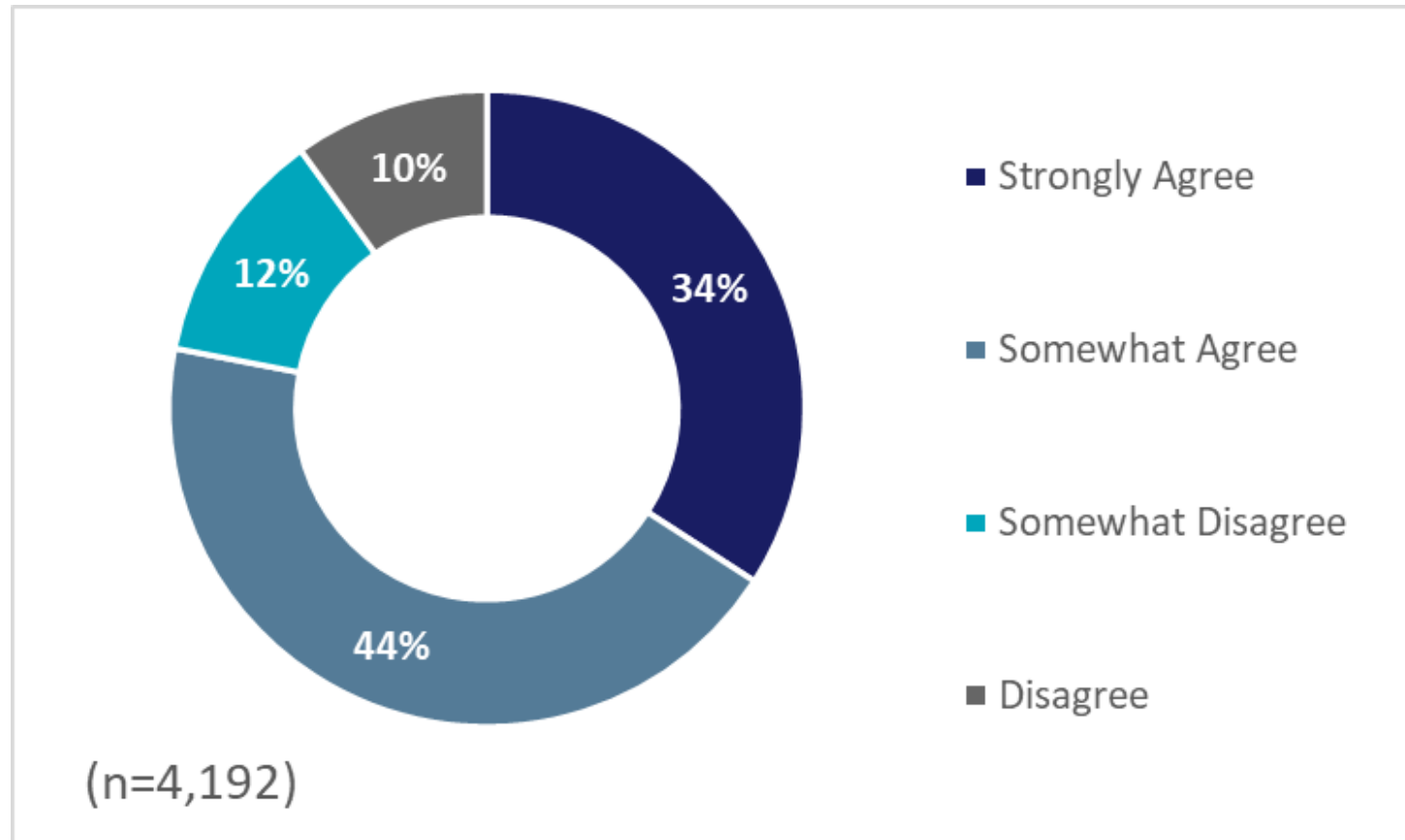
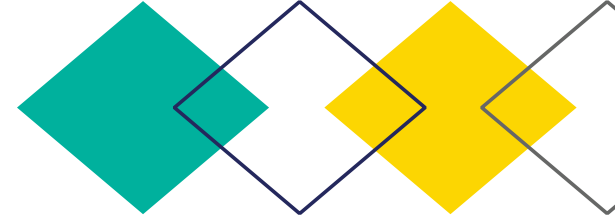
# What rightsizing objectives are LEAST important to you? (Choose 2)



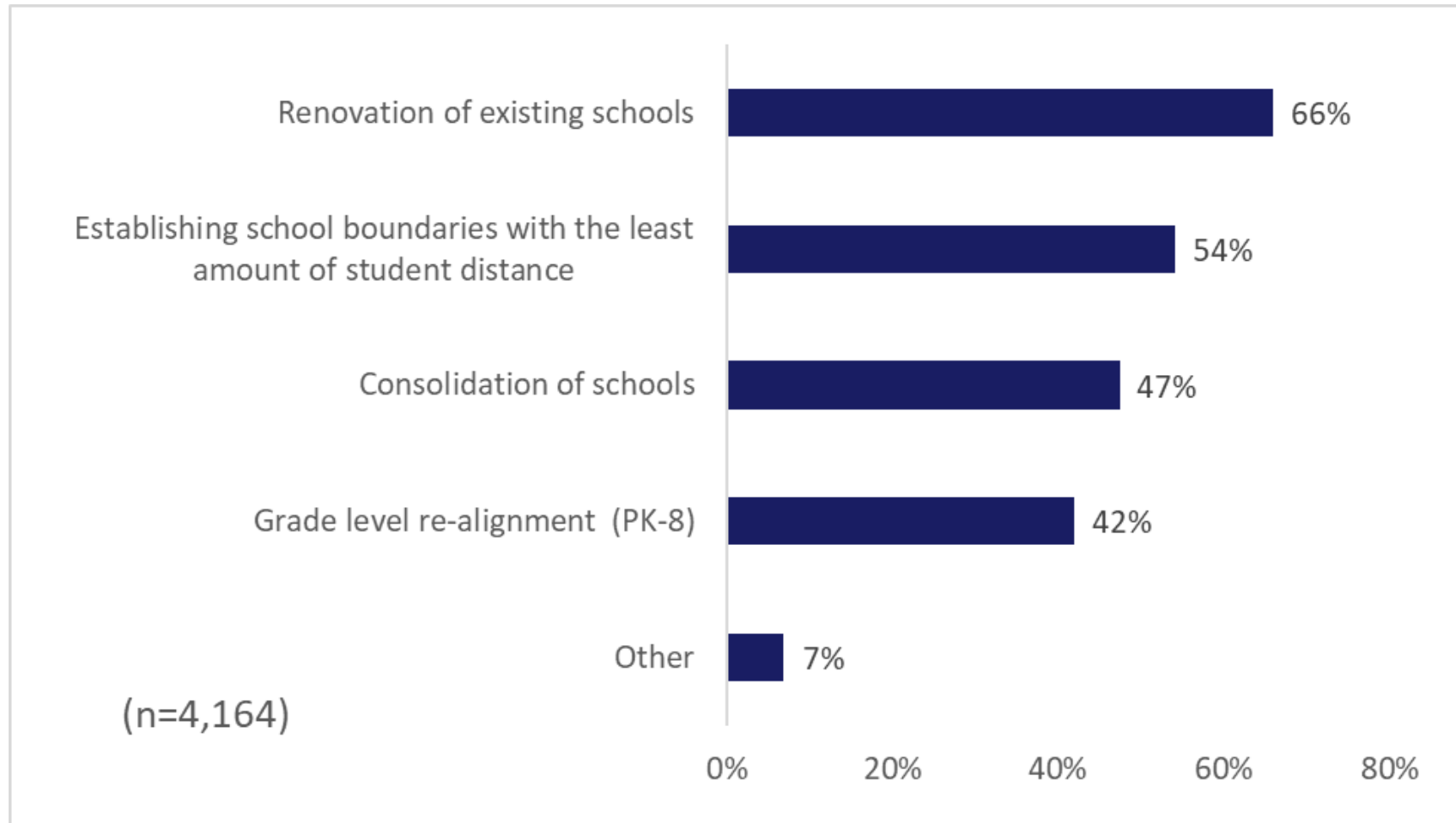
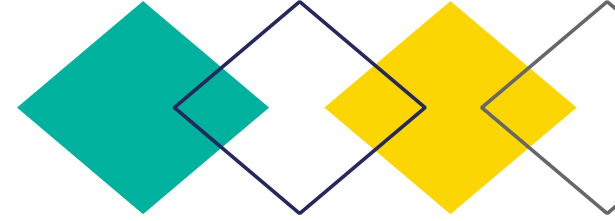
# Of the following options, what should be included in the basic standard requirements of a school building/facility? (Choose 5)



I would support school boundary changes for resident locations to balance enrollment and optimize facility usage among all boundary schools.



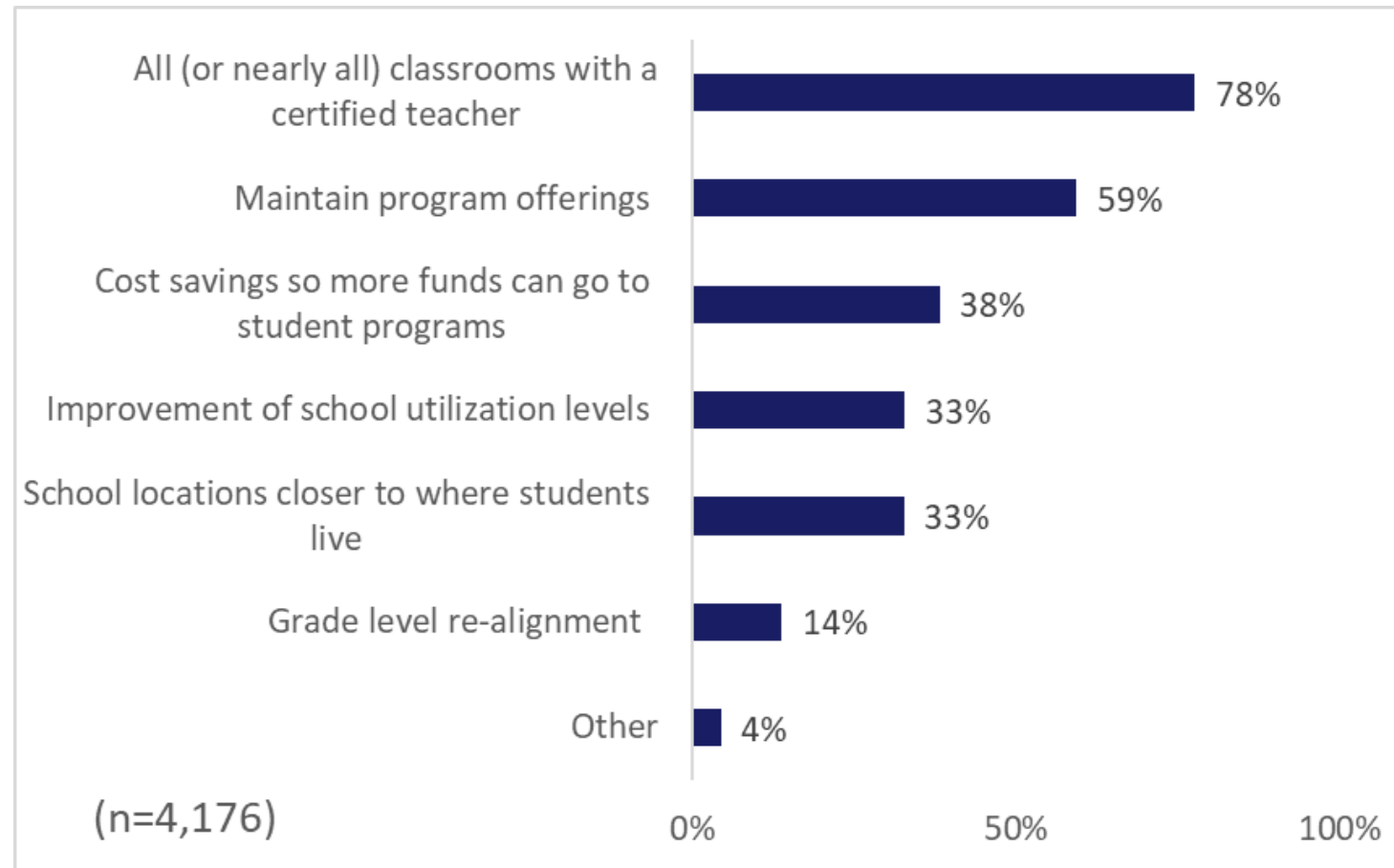
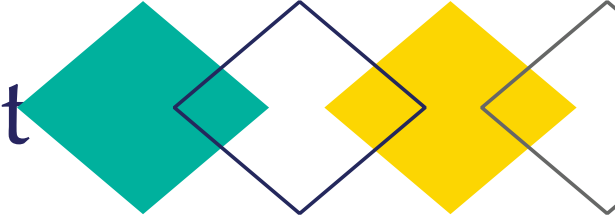
# Which ways to address the issue of school facility optimization would you support MOST?
