

Charles & Juliette Griffin Kenosha Area Boys Scholarship



Background Information

The Charles & Juliette Griffin Kenosha Boys Scholarship was established in 2024 by the family of Charles & Juliette Griffin, partnered with Second Baptist Church of Kenosha and Oakdale Covenant Church of Chicago. The Griffin family has a long history with Second Baptist and the Kenosha area. This scholarship will ensure their legacy lives on. Charles & Juliette spoke with admiration and pride for their sons and grandsons. They acknowledged God's grace, mercy, and blessings that their sons and grandsons had the opportunity to further their education and achieve many accomplishments. This scholarship will be a blessing in providing an opportunity for other young men in the Kenosha area to have a chance and the resources to attend college and go after all God may have in store for them.

The Purpose

The purpose of the Charles & Juliette Griffin Kenosha area boys scholarship is to provide designated monetary support for tuition, books, and other related fees for college to boys in the Kenosha area who are: 1) pursuing an associate, collegiate, or graduate degree; 2) an enrolled student, and 3) attending an accredited higher education institution (undergraduate or graduate).

Criteria

- You must be a resident of the city of Kenosha and a graduate of Kenosha schools.
- You must be attending or accepted to attend an accredited college or university and pursuing a degree (associate, collegiate, or graduate).
- You must be accepted and/or enrolled at an accredited college or university with a minimum of 6 credits, and evidence of acceptance and enrollment is required.
- Have and/or maintain a minimum of 2.0 GPA; evidence of satisfactory GPA is required.
- Have demonstrated leadership, citizenship, and/or volunteerism through participation in school, church, and/or community activities.
- Provide proof of evidence of acceptance into an accredited college or university is required. A scholarship will not be granted to award recipients, and funds will not be distributed to the student's school without this written notification.
- Submit a written essay on why you should be chosen for the scholarship.
- Submit two recommendation or character letters from a school counselor, teacher, principal, or community member.
- Submit a completed and signed application with the required documents by the scholarship application deadline date.

Award

2 - \$1,000 scholarships that can be applied towards tuition, books, or other approved fees/expenses related to the costs of attending college. Sophomore, Junior, or Senior status college students can reapply.

How to Apply

An applicant must complete, sign, and return the scholarship application form by the application deadline date. Application Dates

The Charles & Juliette Griffin Kenosha Area Boys Scholarship application period is **Monday, April 1, 2024, to Sunday, May 12, 2024.**

All applications must be received in the Church office by 11:00 am on May 12th. Late applications will not be considered.

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Distribution of Funds

Disbursement of any monies for scholarship award recipients shall be paid directly and made payable to the award recipient's school and not to the individual once the individual has provided official acceptance and class registration documentation.

The committee may award more money to the successful applicant based on the number of graduating seniors and available funds.
