- 2. A graduating senior (Class of 2024), age 20 years of age or under by the application deadline of October 15.
- 3. In their final academic year (senior year) of secondary education at time of application deadline.
- 4. Minimum cumulative unweighted GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 5. Citizen or legal permanent resident of the United States or Canada.
- 6. Plans to attend an accredited post-secondary educational institution in the United States or Canada full-time or part-time in the fall of the academic year following her high school graduation.
- 7. Recommended by a P.E.O. chapter. *
