





16 refrigerated crescent rolls (2 tubes of 8 rolls)

1 green onions thinly sliced

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees F. Coat a 9-inch x 13-inch baking dish with non-stick spray. Set aside.
- 2. Brown sausage in a large skillet over medium-high heat until browned all the way through, about 6 to 8 minutes. Be sure to break up the sausage as it cooks. Remove from heat and strain off grease. Set aside.
- 3. In a large mixing bowl, whisk together eggs, half-n-half, salt, pepper, onion powder, and paprika until fully incorporated. Add cheese and stir to combine. Set aside.
- 4. Open crescent rolls and roll according to package directions. Arrange 15 rolls in the prepared baking dish in three rows with 5 rolls in each row. Add sausage to the baking dish, spreading it evenly over the rolls. Pour the egg mixture over the rolls and sausage.
- 5. Bake for 25 minutes. Carefully remove from the oven. Allow to sit for 5 minutes. Sprinkle top with green onions, if desired. Serve warm.

Ingredients

Almond Blueberry Coffee Cake

2 cups granulated sugar

- 3 large eggs, room temperature
- 12 tablespoons salted butter, room temperature
- 1 teaspoon pure almond extract
- 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 12 ounces fresh blueberries, or frozen and thawed
- 1 cup sliced almonds

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Spray a 9×13 baking pan with cooking spray. Set aside.
- 2. In the bowl of a stand mixer, fitted with a paddle attachment, (or a large mixing bowl and an electric mixer), beat sugar and eggs for 5 minutes with a mixer on medium. The volume of mixture will increase by almost half and will be thickened and light in color.
- 3. Add butter and extracts and beat for 2 more minutes. Slowly add flour and beat until just combined. Fold in blueberries.
- 4. Using a spatula, pour and smooth batter into prepared pan. Sprinkle almonds on top.
- 5. Bake for 40-45 minutes until a toothpick comes out clean.
- 6. Allow to cool completely before serving, or the cake will crack. If you can't wait, just know it will taste amazing!
