

She wanted to honor her father, William Jackson Smart who raised six children as a single father after his wife died. The idea of officially celebrating fatherhood spread across the United States, as more and more states adopted the holiday. In 1924, President Calvin Coolidge supported the idea of a national Father's Day and encouraged other states to celebrate the day. Finally, in 1966 President Lyndon B. Johnson signed a presidential proclamation declaring the 3rd Sunday of June as Father's Day. Then, six years later, President Nixon finally made Father's Day a federal holiday.

Stepfathers, uncles, godfathers, grandfathers, and adult male friends are all honored on Father's Day. Easy Grape Jelly Meatballs

Ingredients

28 ounces grape jelly
12 ounces Heinz chili sauce or favorite BBQ sauce
32 ounces frozen meatballs, fully cooked
1 Tablespoon cornstarch + 3 tsp water to thicken
hot sauce (optional)



Directions


1. Spray the inside bowl of a slow cooker with non-stick cooking spray.
2. Place frozen meatballs in the slow cooker first.
3. Pour the grape jelly and chili sauce over the meatballs. Give it a stir to make sure the meatballs are all coated.
4. Cook on high for 2 hours, or low for 4 hours.
5. Once the meatballs are done cooking, add in the cornstarch slurry. Stir and continue to cook until sauce starts to thicken. This will take about 3 minutes. Change the slow cooker setting to the warm setting until you are ready to serve them. Serve with toothpicks or as a meal with rice.



Bill's Sausage Gravy

Ingredients

1 12-ounce package maple flavored sausage
3 Tablespoons butter
1/4 cup all-purpose flour
3 cups whole milk
Salt and pepper to taste



Directions

1. Place sausage in a large, deep skillet. Cook and crumble over medium-high heat until evenly brown.
2. Remove sausage with a slotted spoon, leaving the drippings in the pan. Stir butter into the pan until melted. Add flour and stir until smooth. Reduce heat to medium and cook until light brown. Gradually whisk in milk and cook until thickened. Season with salt and pepper.
3. Add cooked sausage back to the skillet. Reduce heat and simmer for 12 to 15 minutes. If gravy becomes too thick, stir in a little more milk.


