





- 1. Cut tops off peppers and discard; remove seeds. Blanch peppers in boiling water for 5 minutes. Drain and rinse in cold water; set aside.
- 2. In a bowl, combine beef, 1/4 cup tomato sauce, rice, 2 tablespoons cheese, onion, Worcestershire sauce, salt, pepper and egg; mix well. Stuff the peppers; place in an ungreased 1-1/2-qt. baking dish. Pour the remaining tomato sauce over peppers. Cover and bake at 350° for 45-60 minutes or until meat is no longer pink and peppers are tender.
- 3. Sprinkle with remaining cheese; return to the oven for 5 minutes or until cheese is melted.

Avocado Toast with Egg

Ingredients

- 1 teaspoon butter
- 2 eggs
- 2 slices multigrain bread
- 1 ripe avocado, pitted, peeled
- 1 teaspoon lemon juice, or to taste
- 1 pinch cayenne pepper
- sea salt to taste
- ground black pepper to taste

Instructions

- 1. Melt butter in a skillet over medium-low heat. Crack eggs into the skillet side by side and cook until eggs are white on the bottom layer and firm enough to flip, 2 to 3 minutes. Flip eggs, trying not to crack the yolk, and cook until egg reaches desired doneness, 2 to 5 minutes more.
- 2. Meanwhile, toast bread slices to desired doneness, 3 to 5 minutes.
- 3. Mash avocado in a bowl; stir in lemon juice, cayenne pepper, and sea salt. Spread avocado mixture onto toast. Top with fried egg and season with sea salt and pepper.


