- 3. Watch for Signals and Streetcars Obey all warning signs and lights, and be mindful that streetcars cannot stop suddenly.
- 4. **Give Streetcars Space** Avoid standing too close to the tracks and never play or place objects near them.
- 5. **Board Safely and Respectfully** If using streetcars for transportation, wait until they come to a full stop before boarding or exiting.
