Wishing you and your loved ones a safe, warm, and happy Thanksgiving.

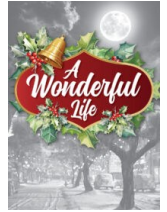

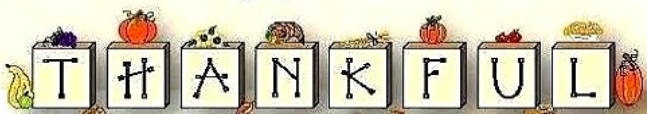
