COFFEE @ the Senior Center

We want to keep coffee available and affordable for everyone, but we also need to ensure the program remains sustainable.

After reviewing the cost of supplies and the amount collected throughout the day we've found that the Senior Center is covering much more than what is being contributed.

Remember that we only charge 25¢ per cup, and that price includes the coffee, sugar, creamers, and the cup.

To keep the coffee price at **25¢ per cup** and avoid raising costs or discontinuing it, we are asking all members to help by following these guidelines.

- Use only the cups provided by the Senior Center.
- Make payment every time you enjoy coffee.
- Deposit 25¢ each time you refill your cup.

Because of the ongoing shortfall in contributions, coffee will no longer be free during donut days starting in 2026.

This change helps ensure we can continue offering coffee throughout the week without increasing the price.






