

Kenosha Professional Police Association (KPPA) Scholarship

Who is eligible to apply?

Any graduating high school senior attending an accredited institute of higher learning, two (2) or four (4)-year college, or vocational technical school as a full-time student.

Financial Data:

The scholarship award amount is \$1,000, non-renewable. The money will be paid directly to the college or vocational technical school being attended by the recipient. The money will be awarded after the completion of the first semester with a passing GPA of 2.0 or higher and good standing within their community.

Selection Process:

Applicants will be reviewed by the Kenosha Professional Police Association (KPPA) Scholarship Committee. All decisions of the committee are final. The deadline for the applications is April 1st. Any applications not postmarked by April 1st will be disqualified.

Step 1:

Complete the attached application form, labeled part 1.

Step 2:

Ask two (2) people to submit letters of recommendation for you. Appropriate references are principals, counselors, teachers, employers, or supervisors of community or volunteer organizations in which you have been active. It is highly recommended that at least one (1) recommendation be from a principal, teacher, or counselor.

Step 3:

On a separate sheet of paper, submit a **typed** personal statement of 250 words or less. Use the following as an outline for your statement, but be creative.

1. Describe your future goals.
2. Briefly describe the most important school and/or community activities in which you have been involved, or honors/awards you have received in the last four (4) years.
