APPLICATION PROCESS

The application for full-time Middle and High School students is now available on our website. If applications exceed the number of allotted spots for Kenosha eSchool, a lottery system will be implemented. Students who are accepted will be making a one-year commitment to Kenosha eSchool and will not be allowed to exit early (staffing is based on enrollment numbers). For this reason, we ask that you pay close attention to how eSchool works, and spend time consulting with your spouse, child, and any other individuals responsible for your child's academic progress or plan before making a decision.

PART-TIME

We will be offering part-time enrollments for the upcoming year. Students should work with their home school counselors to determine what eSchool courses they should take, and then complete the steps for part-time registration found on our website

WHAT IS KENOSHA ESCHOOL?


The Kenosha eSchool is a fully-accredited, online charter school serving students since 2007. Kenosha eSchool offers full and part-time enrollment options for Kenosha Unified School District students.

WHY CHOOSE ONLINE LEARNING?

FLEXIBILITY: Students are able to work at any time of day or night in the location they choose. This flexible time table allows students to create a personalized schedule to meet their needs.

PACING: The pacing of this program allows for students to work at an accelerated pace if they choose.

PART-TIME: Many students elect to take one or two courses with Kenosha eSchool. This creates more flexibility in their schedules for alternate activities and courses both in their boundary schools and out of school activities.



CHARACTERISTICS OF A SUCCESSFUL ONLINE STUDENT



PARENT/GUARDIAN SUPPORT: Are you

able to monitor and support your child with their learning? This model requires a tremendous amount of parental support.

TIME MANAGEMENT: Can you and your child create a schedule that they will adhere to each day? This requires students to work each day on their own without face-to-face instruction.

ACADEMIC READINESS: Does your child have

basic reading, writing and math skills necessary to be successful? Does your child have a strong understanding of the English language?

TECHNOLOGY SKILLS: Can you and your child

navigate websites effectively? Are you familiar with Zoom meetings, accessing Google Documents, using online tools such as calculators and dictionaries, basic email communication (most of our communication is done via email).

SELF-MOTIVATED: Does your child complete tasks without constant redirection? Can they focus on a goal and stay motivated?

SELF-ADVOCATE: Does your child seek out assistance when they are having difficulty? Are they able to contact instructors when they are not understanding something?

PREVIOUS YEAR SUCCESS: Was your child

successful in previous years with synchronous online learning? All students may apply. We offer assistance in both Special Education and ELL. We do ask that you consult with your current school's case manager/ELL teacher to discuss whether this is an appropriate choice for your child.
